

Bark Sea Fox Cruising on New Holland
Sunday June 15th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the Bark standing to the Southward. all hands employed boiling. Saw several vessels Merchantmen Steaming to the Northward
Lat 22.48 S Long 107.35

Monday June 16th Comes in with fine weather and light southerly winds, the Bark steering to the Westward Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing but finbacks, and porpoises. finished boiling about 8 P.M. latter part employed Coopering.
Lat 22.45 S Long 106.30

Stowing Down oil Tuesday June 17th Comes in with light trade winds. the Bark steering by the wind to the Westward Middle and latter part. the wind light and variable. all hands employed Stowing down oil in the Main Hatchway finished about 5 P.M.
Lat 22.25 S Long 105.42

Spoke an English Ship Wednesday June 18th This day Comes in with fine weather and light trades the Bark steering to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw Whales going S.W. lowered three Boats. the Whales went off.
Lat 22.58 S Long 105.09

Thursday June 19th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the North the Bark steering to the S.W. at 5 A.M. Saw the Whales again going S.W. to the S.W. at 9 A.M. lowered the three Boats. the Starboard Boat went alongside of a 60 barrel Whale and missed him with a good Chance. took up the Boats and let the Whales get still and then lowered again. Struck and speared one of them to the ship at sunset.
Lat 23.40 S Long 104.40

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Friday June 20th Comes in with fine weather and light winds from the N.E. Steaming about S.W. with Whales in sight at 2 P.M. lowered the three Boats. the Starboard Boat struck and stove. the other Boats saved the Whale got him to the ship about sunset. got supper and commenced cutting. got the head off and body in about 4 A.M. latter part squally and rainy weather hoisted in the head, and set the watch.

Lat by D.R. 23.30 S Long 104.30 E

Saturday June 21st Comes in with fresh Gale from the N.W. the wind veering to the W.S.W. the Bark laying two under close reefed main top sail & fore sail. boiling head. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing.
Lat 23.53 S Long 105.15 E

Sunday June 22^d This day Comes in with fresh Gale from the Westward the Bark steering to N.W. under short sail. Employed boiling. Saw one or two Merchantmen. latter part weather more moderate.
Lat 23.16 S Long 104.45 E

Monday June 23^d Comes in with fine weather and light southerly winds. the Bark steering to the S.E. Employed boiling and repairing the Starboard Boat. finished boiling about noon. Saw nothing.
No obs.

Tuesday June 24th This day fine weather and light winds the Bark steering S.E. Middle and latter part fine weather Employed Coopering oil and Stowing down. finished repairing the Starboard Boat and put her on the cranes. Saw porpoises ends with good weather.
