Thursday June 26<sup>th</sup> First part fresh Gale from S.W. the Bark steering E.N.E. Middle part lying with the main yard aback, at daylight Steered off East. Middle and latter part squally. all hands employed stowing down oil. Stowed off the fore peak.

Friday June 27<sup>th</sup> Comes in with fresh Breezes from the S.W. the Bark steering to the N.W. Middle and latter part much the same Employed washing Ship. Ends with good weather  
Lat 22.30<sup>s</sup> Long 108.48 E.

Saturday June 28<sup>th</sup> Comes in with fresh Breezes, and squally weather the Bark steering by the Wind to the N.W. Middle and latter part the weather more moderate. Saw plenty of finbacks. Mr. Leaven off Duty Sick  
Lat 22.28<sup>s</sup> Long 108.41

Sunday June 29<sup>th</sup> This day Comes in with fine weather and light baffaling winds the Bark heading to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the same - Saw finbacks and porpoises. Ends with fine weather  
Lat 22.58<sup>s</sup> Long 108.45 E

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Monday June 30<sup>th</sup> This day Comes in with light winds and clear weather, the Bark steering to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the same, Saw plenty of finbacks  
Employed painting Boats.  
Lat 23.77<sup>s</sup> Long 108.41 E.

Tuesday July 1<sup>st</sup> Comes in with fresh breezes from the Westward the Bark steering by the Wind to the N.W. Saw nothing but finbacks. Employed about various jobs. Ends with fine weather  
Lat 22.25<sup>s</sup> Long 108.28

Wednesday July 2<sup>nd</sup> Comes in with good weather and light winds. the Bark on different tacks middle and latter part, light South Westerly winds. Steering N.E. Saw finbacks. Ends with fine weather Employed Repairing Main top sail  
Lat 22.30<sup>s</sup> Long 108.16

Thursday July 3<sup>rd</sup> Comes in with light breezes from the N.W. the Bark steering to the S.E. Middle and latter part much the same. The Watch employed Scraping and painting iron work. Saw finbacks.  
Lat 23.00 Long 108.33  
Crewer Abs 18.59

Friday July 4<sup>th</sup> Comes in with gentle trades and clear weather the Bark steering N.E. Middle and latter part the weather about the same Saw finbacks. Employed setting up the Head Rigging, lowers for Black jib.  
Lat 22.10<sup>s</sup> Long 108.32
