Monday Aug 4<sup>th</sup> Comes in with fine Breezes from the Westward at daylight got under weigh with all sail set and went out of the Straits. We have been in Port 2 Weeks and gave the men 4 days liberty each watch. I have bought 37 piculs potatoes about 20 piculs of yams. for the sweet potatoes I payed 4 rups for the yams 4.50 rups. beef 12 cents a pound pumpkin 7 rups for 100. I sold good Whales teeth for 80 cents an ounce money. and 111 Squalone Cow Whales teeth for \$22.00 at sunset the S.E. end of Java been about 1/2 M.

Tuesday Aug 5<sup>th</sup> This day Comes in with Moderate Trade Winds the Bark Steering by the Wind heading S. by W. Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing of importance  
Lat 10.15. S Long 114.50 E.

Wednesday Aug 6<sup>th</sup> Comes in with moderate trades and fine Weather the Bark Steering by the Wind heading S. by E. Middle and latter part fine weather. Saw Blackfish did not lower. they were going to windward. Employed making spun yarn.  
Lat 12.18 S Long 112.54 E.

Thursday Aug 7<sup>th</sup> Comes in with moderate Winds from the S.E. Steering by the wind to the Southward Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing of importance Employed making spun yarn and working on the rigging  
Lat 13.58 S Long 112.47 E

## Bark Sea Fox Cruising for Whales.

Friday Aug 8<sup>th</sup> This day Comes in with light trades the Bark heading S. by W. by the Wind middle and latter part nearly Calm. Saw nothing of importance Cooper at work making breakers the watch Employed working on the rigging

Saturday Aug 9<sup>th</sup> Comes in with light trades the Bark heading to the S. by W. at 9 A.M. Saw two party based Whales going slow to the N.W. by N. Middle and latter the weather Calm at 10 A.M. lowered for the Whales about Noon the Seaboard Boat Struck. The Whale ran and Sprung and after being fast about 4 hours the iron drew and lost the Whale in  
Lat 16.23 S Long 111.33 E.

Sunday Aug 10 First part moderate trades and fine Weather the Bark Steering by the wind to the South Middle part lying with the main topsail to the mast. Saw nothing at daylight Wore Ship and struck by the Wind to the South. Saw something Spout several times but saw it no more.  
Lat 16.13 S Long 111.03 E.

Monday Aug 11<sup>th</sup> Comes in with light Winds and Squally Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing. Ends with strong breezes. This morning the Steward was put in irons for negligence and insolence  
Lat 17.10 S Long 110.32 E

Tuesday Aug 12 Comes in with fresh Breezes from the S.E. Steering by the Wind to the Southward middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing of importance  
Lat 19.00 S Long 109.41 E
