

Bark Sea Fox Cruising on New Holland

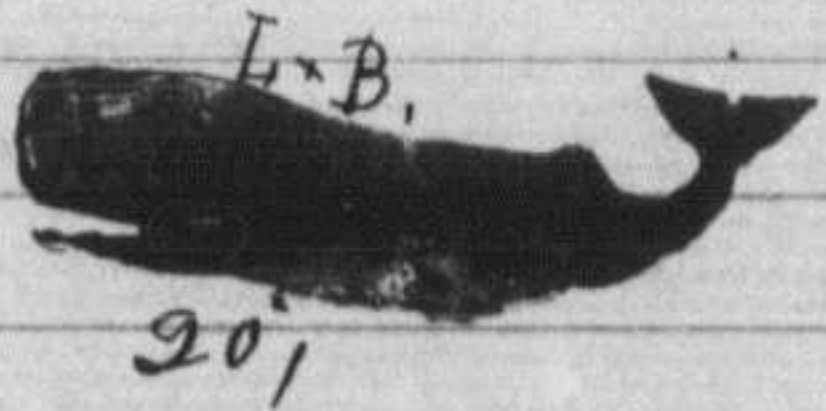
Tuesday Sept 16th Comes in with fine weather and light breezes from the N.E. Steering E. by S. Middle and latter part much the same. Ends with fresh breeze from S.S.W. Saw finbacks.

Wednesday Sept 17th This day Comes in with fresh breezes from S.S.W. Steering E.S.E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing but a few finbacks. Employed fitting rigging. Making mats for foremast rigging. Lat 25.30 S Long 109.13 E

Thursday Sept 18th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.S.W. Steering S.E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing. Ends with squally weather and rain. Lat 27.34 S Long 109.53 E

Friday Sept 19th Comes in with squally weather the Bark Steering S.E. Middle and latter part rainy and squally. Spoke Bark Heathlem. and with rough weather. Lat 28.55 S Long 109.00

Saturday Sept 20th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from S.W. Steering E by South at 1 P.M. Saw Whales going N.N.W. quick lowered three Boats the Leeward Boat struck and saved a small Whale. The Waist Boat was lost by a loose Whale. lost the line and some other small articles. Lat 29.25 Long 110.17 E

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Sunday Sept 21st Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.E. Steering. Employed cutting in a small Whale finished about 9 A.M. and made all sail Steering to the S.W. Middle and latter nearly Calm, at 3 P.M. saw two Whales going to the S.E. Lowered all three Boats without success. the Whales went off quick to Windward. Lat 29.16 Long 110.05

Monday Sept 22^d Comes in with light breezes from the Eastward the Bark Steering to the Southward by the Wind. Employed boiling. Middle and latter part Calm. Saw nothing, but birds and small fish. Lat 29.29 S Long 110.12 E

Tuesday Sept 23^d Comes in with light breezes from the Eastward the Bark Steering by the wind to the S.W. at day light More round to the North. saw finbacks. finished boiling about 3 P.M. Lat 29.02 S Long 110.00 E

Wednesday Sept 24th This day Comes in with fresh breezes from the N.E. the Bark Steering S.E. Saw 3 Humpbacks. latter part, rainy and squally. Ends with clear weather. Cooper Employed fitting up 2 Boats for water. Lat 29.00 S Long 111.14 E

Thursday Sept 25th First part of this day, our hours fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.W. the Bark Steering to the W.N.W. by the wind. saw a few finbacks. all hands Employed Stowing down oil in the fore hold finished about dark. Lat 28.46 S Long 111.04 E
