

Bark Sea Fox Cruising on New Holland.

Friday Sept 26. Comes in with fresh Breezes from the Westward the Bark steering by the wind to the S.W. Middle and latter part squally and rainy. Saw a Merchantman steering to the North
Lat 29.15 S Long 111.04

Saturday Sept 27. Fresh breezes and squally weather, the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the same. Ends with fine weather. The watch Employed repairing the main top sail our vessel in sight
Lat 28.55 S Long 110.16 E.

Sunday Sept 28th This day Commences with fine weather and moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same saw nothing of importance. Ends with fine weather one vessel in sight, at sunset saw sperm Whales one rising
Lat 28.55 S Long 110.46 E.

Monday Sept 29th Comes in with light trade winds. The Bark steering on different tacks looking for the Whales. Middle and latter part much the same saw one vessel to the Northward
Lat 28.30 S Long 111.17

Tuesday Sept 30th These twenty four hours fresh Breezes from the S.E. steering on different tacks saw nothing but small fish spoke the Bark Mary Frazer. Ends with squally weather Employed repairing sparker
Lat 28.30 S Long 111.51 E

Wednesday Sept. Oct 1st This day fresh breezes and squally weather wind from N.W. Middle and latter part much the same saw a Brush. Employed repairing the foresail
Lat 28.25 S Long 111.57 E

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Thursday Oct 2. This day Comes in with fine weather and light winds from the S.E. the Bark steering to the Westward. Saw fishbacks. The Mary Frazer in sight. Employed repairing foresail & side.
Lat 28.51 S Long 112.01

Friday Oct 3. Comes in with moderate winds from the Westward the Bark heading on different tacks middle and latter part much the same saw nothing of importance. The Mary Frazer in sight. Standing to the Westward
Lat 29.07 Long 111.37 E.

Saturday Oct 4th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks middle and latter part much the same saw nothing of importance. The Mary Frazer in sight to seaward.
Lat 28.42 S Long 111.52

Sunday Oct 5th Comes in with light breezes from the Southward. The Bark heading to the N.W. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw no fish of any description. Ends with fine weather
Lat 29.17 S Long 109.45 E

Monday Oct 6th. Comes in with fresh Breezes from the S.E. the Bark heading on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with fresh Breezes. one vessel in sight
Lat 29.40 S Long 108.50 E

Tuesday Oct 7th This day Comes in with fine weather and light winds from the Southward. the Bark heading to S.W. at sunset tacked to the Eastward Middle and latter part pleasant weather. Saw Merchantman
Lat 29.30 S Long 109.29
