

1. Bark Sea Fox Cruising on the South Coast of Java

Friday Oct 31st Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw porpoises. Ends with fine weather.

Lat 11.50^s Long 112.07. E.

Saturday Nov 1st This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate trade winds the Bark standing on different tacks middle and latter part fresh trades. Saw nothing. Ends with fine weather.

Lat 12.00^s Long 111.25 E.

Sunday Nov 2nd These twenty four hours fine weather and steady trade winds the Bark on different tacks working to windwards. Middle and latter part winds moderate. Saw a few porpoises. There is a strong current setting to the N.W.

Lat 12.40^s Long 111.20 E.

Monday Nov 3rd First part of this day fresh breezes and clear weather the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part steady trades. Turning by the wind to the Eastwards. Saw nothing of importance. So ends our first year all well.

Lat 13.00^s Long 113.04 E.

Tuesday Nov 4th This day Comes in with fresh trades and fine weather the Bark heading on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. a few finbacks and porpoises and other small fry.

Lat 13.10^s Long 112.52. E.

Wednesday Nov 5th Comes in with light trades and splendid weather the Bark standing to the Westwards, at 6 P.M. Saw Whales going S.W. to N.W.

Lat 13.10^s Long 112.40. Lowered three Boats. The Leadboard Boat struck and saved three Whales got him to the Ship about 8 P.M.

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Thursday Nov 6th This day fine weather and light winds the Bark standing to the S.W. middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing. all hands employed boiling. finished the head about daylight. Saw Blackfish.

Lat 13.20^s Long 111.89. E.

Friday Nov 7th Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw porpoises and other small fry. Ends with fine weather. Finished boiling about 10 P.M.

Lat 13.00^s Long 112.47. E.

Saturday Nov 8th This day Comes in with fresh trades and clear weather the Bark heading to the S.W. Middle and latter part heading to the Eastwards. Saw nothing of importance.

Lat 13.20^s Long 112.46 E.

Sunday Nov 9th First part of this twenty four hours fresh trades and clear weather the Bark heading in different tacks. Middle and latter part fine weather. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with good weather. Saw nothing.

Lat 13.25^s Long 112.47. E.

Monday Nov 10th Comes in with moderate trades and clear weather the Bark heading to the Eastwards all hands employed Stowing down oil in the fore hold. Saw porpoises.

Lat 13.10^s Long 113.04 E.

Tuesday Nov 11th This day Comes in with fine weather and light trades the Bark heading to the W.S.W. Middle and latter part nearly calm. Saw nothing of importance. Employed Stowing away coals. The cooper repairing casks.

Lat 13.24^s Long 113.30 E.
