Monday Dec 8th This day fresh trades and clear weather. The Bark heading by the wind to the Southward. Middle and latter part about the same. Saw nothing. Employed setting up fore & aft Backstays.
Lat 14.52 S Long 109.37 E.

Tuesday Dec 9th Comes in with moderate breezes from S.E. The Bark on the S.W. tack. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Employed setting up the mainmast backstays. and Sundry Jobs. The Cook off duty sick.
Lat 15.46 S Long 107.45 E.

Wednesday Dec 10th First part of this day fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.E. Heading to the Southward by the wind. Employed setting fore and aft Stays. Saw porpoises. The Cook some better.
Lat 16.07 S Long 106.04.

Thursday Dec 11th This day Comes in with fine weather and fresh trades. The Bark heading to the S.W. by the Wind. Saw nothing of importance. Employed overhauling blocks.
Lat 17.00 S Long 104.26 E.

Friday Dec 12th Comes in with fine weather and fresh trades. The Bark Steering by the wind to the S.E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with strong trades. No obs.

Saturday Dec 13th This day Comes in with fine weather and fresh trades. The Bark heading by the Wind to the S.W. Middle and latter part fresh breezes and squally. Saw nothing of importance. Employed shooing Casks and welling holds.
Lat 22.40 S Long 101.32 E.

Sunday Dec 14th First part of this day fresh trades. Steering by the wind to the Southward. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw a School of Grampuses. Ends with fresh trades.
Lat 24.40 S Long 100.24 E.

Monday Dec 15th First part of this day light baffling winds from the Southward. The Bark heading to the Eastward. Saw a finback or two. Employed breaking out for meat. Ends with light winds.
Lat 26.24 S Long 99.52 E.

Tuesday Dec 16th This day Comes in with light baffling winds from the South East. The Bark on the wind heading to the S.W. Middle part nearly Calm. Saw nothing. Employed washing Ship outside.
Lat 27.00 S Long 98.47 E.

Wednesday Dec 17th Comes in with light Winds and variable. The Bark on the Southern tack. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with fresh breezes. Employed breaking out and Hoisting away in the main hatch.
Lat 28.40 S Long 98.42 E.
