Tuesday May 26th This day Comes in with fresh Gale from the W.S.W. the Bark heading to the N.W. Middle and latter part much the same saw nothing of importance Employed fitting the Spanker Gaff.

Wednesday May 27th First part of this day fresh Breezes from the S.W. The Bark heading to the S.W. Middle & latter part Wind from S.E. Steering E.S.E. Saw one or two finbacks.

Thursday May 28th First part of this day fine Weather and moderate Breezes from the S.E. The Bark heading to the Eastward Middle and latter part Steering to the Westward saw nothing of importance.
Lat 25.30 Long 108.25

Friday May 29th This day fine Weather and moderate Breezes from S.E. The Bark Steering by the Wind to the W.S.W. at daylight Wore Ship and Steered E by N. Saw a few birds. The Watch Employed making Spun yarn and painting plank ship.
Lat 25.30 Long 108.48

Saturday May 30th Comes in with fresh Breezes from the S.E. The Bark heading E.S.E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing but Blackfish and finbacks. Looked for the Blackfish without Success. latter part Wind fresh & Squally.
Lat 24.35 Long 109.38

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Sunday May 31st This day Comes in with fresh Breezes from E. The Bark heading E.S.E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw a large Merchant man Steering to the N.W.
Lat 23.57 Long 112.00

Monday June 1st This day Comes in with fresh Breezes from the S.E. The Bark on the Eastern Tack Middle and latter part quite moderate. Saw Blackfish and other small fry. at 2 P.M. Saw the Land bearing S.E. about 25 miles Dist.
Lat 23.25 Long 113.00

Tuesday June 2^d First part calm Middle part light wind off the Land. The Bark Steering N.W. Eng. with four Breezes from E.S.E. Saw nothing of importance. Employed painting Ship inside.
Lat 22.41 Long 112.00

Wednesday June 3^d Comes in with fresh & Northerly winds. The Bark Steering S.W. by W. Middle and latter part moderate. Saw finbacks & Blackfish. Looked for the Blackfish, without Success.
No obs.

Thursday June 4th First part of this day Squally Weather and rainy with Northerly winds. The Bark Steering to the Westward. Middle part wind from the Southward Steering W.N.W. Saw a few finbacks & some birds.
