

Bark Sea Fox Cruising for Whales

Friday June 5th 1862. Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.E. The Bark steering off N.W. Middle part laying too with the head yards aback. at daylight heeled off a little saw finbacks. The watch employed getting a new main top sail lifts

Lat 23.15 S Long 109.17 E

Saturday June 6th This day Comes in with fine weather and strong trade wind The Bark steering to the North at sunset heeled to the wind to the Southward. Middle and latter part weather much the same, saw birds plenty of them.

Lat 22.40 S Long 108.15 E

Sunday June 7th Comes in with fresh Trades & Squally weather the Bark heading to the Southward. Middle & latter part more moderate. saw nothing of importance ends with fine weather

Lat 23.35 S Long 108.11 E

Monday June 8th First part of this day good weather and moderate breezes from the E.S.E. The Bark heading on different tack middle & latter part fine weather saw nothing but birds & one finback.

Lat 23.24 S Longitude 108.30
Chron 107.55

Tuesday June 9th This day Comes in with fine weather and light winds from the E.S.E. The Bark heading to the North, Middle & latter part much the same saw one sail steering to North.

Lat by D. R. 22.30 Longitude 107.20

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Wednesday June 10th Comes in with fine weather & moderate breezes from the S.W. The Bark steering to the N.E. Middle & latter part rainy & Squally. Saw nothing of importance

Lat 23.10 S Long 108.14 E

Thursday June 11th First part of this day rainy weather The Bark steering to the S.W. Middle & latter part fine weather. Saw nothing of importance. The watch employed repairing the Sill.

Lat 23.08 S Long 107.36 E

Friday June 12th Comes in with rainy Squally weather the Bark heading to the Westward by the wind at 9 A.M. Heeled off N.W. Middle & latter part fine weather. Saw one or two finbacks.

Lat 22.35 S Long 106.25 E

Saturday June 13th First part of this day moderate breezes from the South The Bark steering N.W. Middle & latter part much the same saw nothing of importance. Employed repairing the flying Sill.

Lat 22.55 S Long 105.53 E

Sunday June 14th This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate Trades the Bark steering by the Wind to the S.W. Middle and latter part quite moderate. Saw a few finbacks and other small fry.

Lat 23.30 S Long 105.47 E
