

Bark Sea Fox Cruising for Whales.

Thursday Aug 27th Comes in with moderate breeze from N.E. the Bark off Sava Thach beating to windward with a head tide and head wind and losing ground all the time at 3 P.M. the wind shifted to the S.W. Hired N.E. at 9 A.M. anchored in 25 fathoms. as the wind all died away, and wanted to hold all we had gained.

Friday Aug 28th at daylight got under weigh with a light breeze, steering for New Bay. at 9 A.M. anchored in 15 fathoms and furled the sails latter part, employed getting a raft of water and half the men cutting wood. filled our raft and brought it on board about 100 barrels.

Saturday Aug 29th First part of this day fine weather Employed wooding and breaking out in the after hold, brought on board about 4 Boat loads of Wood and stowed it away.

Sunday Aug 30th This day Comes in with fresh Breezes from the South the Bark lying at anchor in New Bay Boarded a Merchant Ship and got some papers.

Monday Aug 31st Comes in with moderate Breezes from the Southward Bark at anchor in New Bay, all hands Employed getting wood and stowing it away at 1 P.M. got under weigh with a moderate Breeze from S.E. Steered N.E. for Anfir

Bark Sea Fox at Straits of Sundar

Tuesday Sept 1st First part of this day fine weather and moderate Breezes from the South Steering N.E. by Anfir the Anfir point. at 7 P.M. the Wind died away, and let go anchor in 11 fathoms and furled the sails, but a new Main & Gaff Sail

Wednesday Sept 2^d Comes in with light Breezes from S.E. the Bark beating up to the anchorage at anchor at 10 A.M. anchored in 15 fathoms, and furled the sails. Several Mercha. Chaimen in port

Monday Sept 7th Comes in with fair weather and moderate Breezes from S.W. the Bark ready for sea, waiting for a fair tide with small prospect of a fair Wind

Tuesday Sept 8th This day Comes in with fresh Westerly Winds at 2 P.M. weighed anchor with a head wind and head tide. the Bark gaining a little. Middle part rainy and squally at daylight. Crokatee Island bearing W. by N. 1/2 N. about 2 miles distant.

Wednesday Sept 9th Comes in with fine weather and moderate Breezes from nearly every point of the Compass. Middle & latter part light Winds from the Westward, at noon New Bay ahead, about 2 miles distant.

Thursday Sept 10th Comes in with fresh winds & tide the Bark endeavoring to beat out of the Straits at 8 P.M. Prince's Island bearing N. by W. at 10 P.M. had it 2 points abeam. Got some of the first for 3 m^{phs}
