Monday Sept 21st First part of this day fresh trades and rough weather the Bark steering to the S. S. W. Middle and latter part much the same. Ends with better weather. Saw a few birds.
Lat 20.00 Long 100.24 E

Tuesday Sept 22nd Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the Bark on the Southern tack. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with pleasant weather. Saw a broken Spar. Lat 21.40 Long 100.2 E

Wednesday Sept 23rd This day comes in with moderate breezes from the S. E. the Bark on the Southern tack. at 10 A.M. tacked to the Eastward. Saw one finback. Employed making Sizing Stuff.
Lat 23.20 Long 100.33 E

Thursday Sept 24th Comes in with fresh trades and squally weather the Bark steering by the wind to the South. Middle and latter part fresh Gale the Bark under Short Sail. Saw nothing of importance repairing the Rig.

Friday Sept 25th Fresh Gales and squally weather the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part more moderate. Saw nothing. Employed repairing the foretop sail. Saw nothing.
Lat 25.17 Long 99.06 E

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Saturday Sept 26th 1863. Comes in with fresh Gales from S. E. the Bark heading to the Southward. Saw nothing of importance Ends with strong Breezes.
Lat 26.40 Long 98.17 E

Sunday Sept 27th Comes in with fresh breezes from the S. E. steering by the wind to the Southward. Middle and latter part more moderate. Saw porpoises and Squid.
Lat 28.17 Long 99.45 E

Monday Sept 28th This day comes in with fresh Breezes from S. E. the Bark heading to the S. S. W. by the wind. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw one finback.
Lat 29.47 Long 96.57 E

Tuesday Sept 29th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the S. S. E. steering by the wind to the Eastward. Middle and latter part quite moderate. Saw one finback.
Lat 29.31 Long 98.23 E

Wednesday Sept 30th First part light breeze from the Southward the Bark heading on different tacks. Middle and latter part Calm. Saw porpoises. Employed making spun yarn and rattlin down the Mizzen rigging.
Lat 29.41 Long 99.00 E

Thursday Oct 1st Comes in with fine weather and moderate Breezes from the Westward. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw one Ship steering to the North. Employed repairing the Main sail.
Lat 29.40 Long 101.02 E
