Thursday Nov 5th 1863. This day Comes in with light breezes from the Westward the Bark on different tacks. Saw several Merchant men. Steering to the N.E. Employed working on the rigging. Lat 30.10^s Long 112.35^e

Friday Nov 6th This day Comes in with light breezes from the Westward the Bark steering South. Middle and latter part fresh breezes and squally. Saw a Sail Steering to the North. Lat 31.45^s Long 112.55^e

Saturday Nov 7th First part of this day Moderate breezes from the N.W. the Bark steering S. by E. Middle part nearly calm Ends with light Westerly winds. Saw nothing. Lat 33.16^s Long 113.37^e

Sunday Nov 8th Comes in with fine weather and light breezes from the Westward the Bark steering S. by E. Middle and latter part quite moderate. Saw nothing of importance at 4 P.M. Saw the land. Lat 34.30^s Long 114.25^e

Monday Nov 9th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the Westward. Steering S. E. Middle and latter part fresh breezes and squally. Looked for Blackfish and caught one to the West boat. Lat 35.20^s Long 115.47^e

Tuesday Nov 10th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the Westward the Bark on different tacks. Saw one Merchantman. Employed boiling Blackfish blubber. Lat 35.22^s Long 116.32^e

Bark Sea Fox Cruising on the Holland

Wednesday Nov 11th Comes in with moderate breeze from the Westward Steering by the wind to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw Blackfish and caught 2 small ones. Lat 36.00^s Long 116.10^e

Thursday Nov 12th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the Westward the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part the wind light and variable. Saw nothing of importance. Cape Chatham bearing North 25^{miles}

Friday Nov 13th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the Westward the Bark on the in shore tack. Middle and latter part the wind light and variable. Saw nothing of importance. at 7 A.M. spoke the American ship Grace Sargent. Lat 35.46^s Long 117.07^e

Saturday Nov 14th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from N. Steering S. E. Middle and latter part Calm. Saw porpoises and other small fry. Employed repairing the fore topmast rigging. Lat 35.46^s Long 117.01^e

Sunday Nov 15th Comes in with a calm. Middle part light breeze from N.W. Ends with fresh gale from the N.W. Saw no fish of any description. The land in sight bearing S. by E. 25 miles. Lat 35.30^s Long 118.35^e

Monday Nov 16th Comes in with moderate breezes from the Westward the Bark on the wind on different tacks. Middle and latter part quite fresh gale from the Westward. Saw nothing of importance. Lat 35.25^s Long 118.38^e
