Saturday Dec 12th 1863 Comes in with moderate weather and fine breeze from the southward standing by the Wind on different tacks. Saw nothing of importance. Employed repairing the Harbor Boat. The Land in sight bearing W. N. W. 20 miles
Lat 35.07 Long 117.10 E

Sunday Dec 13th First part of this day fine weather and moderate breezes from the Eastward the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part moderate and cloudy saw the Land Bald head bearing about W. N. W. 30 miles
Lat 35.08 Long 117.02 E

Monday Dec 14th Comes in with fresh breezes from the E. N. E. The Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part fresh gales. Employed repairing the Harbor Boat and painting, &c. Bald Island in sight bearing N. W.
Lat 34.58 Long 117.10 E

Tuesday Dec 15th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the W. S. W. Middle and latter part fresh breeze from S. E. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with fresh breezes.
Lat 35.02 Long 117.00 E

Wednesday Dec 16th Comes in with fresh breezes from the S. E. Steering by the wind on different tacks. Middle part rough weather. Saw nothing at 8 A.M. Steered of N. W. for King George Sound

Bark Sea Fox Cruising for Whales.

Wednesday Dec 23rd 1863. Last Monday left King George Sound with light winds from the South. Steered by the Wind to the E. S. E. yesterday calm. This morning light southerly winds. The Bark on the Harbor tack. 2 vessels in sight. Saw no fish
Lat 35.08 Long 117.10 E

Thursday Dec 24th First part of this day fine weather and moderate breezes from S. E. The Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part nearly calm. Saw two or three ships. Steered to the Westward
Lat 35.24 Long 118.33 E

Friday Dec 25th Comes in with fresh gales from E. N. E. The Bark on the Harbor tack. Middle part standing to the North. Saw nothing of the fish kind. Spike Bark. Clarice, Capt. Gifford, parted company about 4 P.M.
No fish.

Saturday Dec 26th This day Comes in with fresh breezes and rough weather. The Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part steering off North with fine breeze from S. W. Saw the Bark Clarice. Ends with fine weather. the land in sight 25 miles
Lat 35.34 Long 118.44 E

Sunday Dec 27th Comes in with fresh breezes from the S. W. The Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance one sail in sight
Lat 35.02 Long 118.41 E
