Tuesday Jan 19th 1864 Comes in with fresh Breeze from S.W. The Bark Standing in for the land. Middle part moderate but with fresh breezes and Squally with a rough sea on. At noon Bald Island bearing N. by E 18 miles

Wednesday Jan 20th Comes in with fresh breezes from W. the Bark Steering by the Wind to the Southward. Middle part moderate. Latter part light winds from the S.W. Standing in shore. Saw porpoises. Employed repairing the fore sail.
Lat 35.32° Long 118.10°

Thursday Jan 21st First part of this day moderate Breeze from S.W. the Bark Steering on different tacks. Middle part Standing off shore. Latter part light winds and Cloudy weather. Saw porpoises.
Lat 35.30° Long 117.51° E.

Friday Jan 22^d. Comes in with fine weather and moderate Winds from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part quite moderate. Saw Grampuses. Employed repairing the spanker. bent a new maintop sail.
Lat 35.33° Long 116.13° E

Saturday Jan 23^d This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.E. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with good weather.
Lat 35.28° Long 116.10° E

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Sunday Jan 24th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.E. The Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with fine weather.
Lat 35.20° Long 116.28° E

Monday Jan 25th This day Comes in with moderate breezes from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks. at 7 A.M. tacked to the North. Middle and latter part fresh gales from the S.E. at 11 A.M. saw Whales going quick to windward. lowered the 2 quarter Boats. without success. did not leave any chance.
Lat 35.30° Long 115.37° E

Tuesday Jan 26th Comes in with fresh gale from S.E. the Bark Standing to the South. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. finished repairing main top Sail.
Lat 36.09° Long 115.03° E

Wednesday Jan 27th Comes in with moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with good weather. latter part Standing to the Eastward. nearly Calm.
Lat 36.01° Long 115.50

Thursday Jan 28th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the S.E. Steering S. by E. Saw a Merchantman Steering to the Westward. at 2 P.M. Saw Whales going slow to windward. lowered for them the Starboard Boat went up to a Whale back and head and did not dart. the whales milled off to the N.W. about 4 P.M. S. Boat struck and saved a fifty barrel Whale and got him alongside about 5 P.M. Commenced cutting up the Saw off and got Supper at midnight. head off and set the whale.
Lat 35.30° Long 116.00° W
