Monday March 21st 1864. This day Comes in with fine Weather and moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same the Bark Rousseau in Company. both vessels boiling saw no fish.

Lat 27.06^s Long 107.20^e

Tuesday March 22^d Comes in with moderate breeze from S.E. the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part fresh breeze from the S.S.W. finished boiling latter part slowing down head and Coopering oil. two vessels in sight

Lat 26.54^s Long 107.37^e.

Wednesday March 23^d This day fresh breeze and Squally Weather the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the same. all hands employed slowing down oil in the after hold. one vessel in sight

Lat 27.00^s Long 107.52

Thursday March 24th Comes in with fresh breeze from the S.E. the Bark on the Southern tack. Middle and latter part more moderate. Spoke Bark Rousseau and Clarice Ends with fine Weather.

Lat 27.18^s Long 106.52

Friday March 25th These twenty four hours fine Weather and moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark heading to the Eastwards. Middle and latter part about the same. one vessel in sight. Employed repairing the main rail

Lat 26.45^s Long 108.0^e

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Saturday March 26th This day Comes in with moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with fine Weather. the Bark Rousseau in sight

Lat 26.30^s Long 107.34^e.

Sunday March 27th Comes in with a moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance one vessel in sight.

Lat 26.52^s Long 107.44^e

Monday March 28th Comes in with moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance one vessel in sight

Lat 27.02^s Long 107.52^e

Tuesday March 29th These twenty four hours fine Weather and moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark heading on different tacks. Middle and latter part. Standing to the S.W. the Bark Rousseau in Company.

Lat 27.20^s Long 107.22^e

Wednesday March 30th Comes in with moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark on different tacks middle and latter part about the same. Saw one finback. the Bark Rousseau in sight. Employed repairing bulworks and rail Channels
