

Bark Sea Fox Homeward bound.

Saturday July 16th 1864 This day comes in with moderate trades steering W. by S. Middle and latter part quite moderate saw one or two finbacks
Lat 25.20^s Long 50.08^e

Sunday July 17th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the E. N. E. steering W. Middle and latter part quite moderate saw finbacks
Lat 26.24 Long 47.45^e

Monday July 18th Comes in with fine weather and fine Wholesal breeze from S. E. The Bark steering W. Middle & latter part about the same, at 9 A.M. saw five Whales going to windward slow towards for them but got nothing as usual except one Boat Stove, an oar broken & several other small accidents.
Lat 26.40^s Long 45.00^e

Tuesday July 19th Comes in with variable winds the Bark steering W. by S. Middle and latter part about the same saw a finback.
Lat 27.25^s Long 43.50^e

Wednesday July 20th Comes in with moderate breezes from the S. E. Middle & latter part much the same saw nothing of importance employed putting a reef in the S. B. latter part light variable winds
Lat 27.51^s Long 42.40^e

Bark Sea Fox Homeward bound.

Thursday July 21st Comes in with moderate breeze from the N. E. steering W. ^{by S} Middle & latter part nearly calm saw finbacks and other small fry. Ends with Calms
Lat 28.51^s Long 41.24^e

Friday July 22nd Comes in with moderate winds from the Westward steering by the wind to the S. S. W. Middle and latter part standing to the N. W. the winds bearing to the Southward saw nothing employed reefing running rigging.
Lat 28.55^s Long 40.02^e

Saturday July 23rd These twenty four hours light winds and baffling the course W. by S. Middle and latter part nearly calm - saw nothing. Ends with a calm
Lat 28.35^s Long 38.24^e

Sunday July 24th Comes in with a light breeze from the Eastward the Bark steering W. by S. Middle and latter part fresh breezes and rainy weather the winds bearing to the Westward saw a Bark steering to the Eastward
Lat 29.46^s Long 35.29^e

Monday July 25th This day light winds and cloudy weather the Bark steering W. by S. with light Northwesterly winds Middle part about the same latter part nearly calm saw nothing of importance. Employed overhauling the blocks and Sundry Cots.
