

Bark Sea Fox Homeward bound

July 26th Comes in with moderate breeze from the E. N. E. Steering W by S Middle and latter part Calm Saw a fishback Employed overhauling blocks. Took in the waste Boat
Lat 30.35° Long 33.08 E

Wednesday July 27th First part of this day fine weather and light small winds from E to N. Middle and latter part about the same. Saw fishbacks
Lat 30.45° Long 32.36 E
Saw 32.40

Thursday July 28th Comes in with moderate breeze from the N. E. Steering W. Middle part breezing up from the West latter part fresh Gale from the West S. W. Bent a new foresail and tore the old one. The Bark on the larboard tack under close reefed topsails and reefed foresail passed a vessel with the main & mizen top Gallant masts gone, Steering by the wind to the S. E.
Lat 31.00° Long 31.08 E

Friday 29th Comes in with fresh westerly Gale Standing to the W. N. W. Middle & latter part more moderate. Saw the land about daylight. Ends with fine weather
Lat 31.18° Long 30.06 E

Saturday July 30th Comes in with fine breeze from the N. E. the Bark Steering W. by S. Middle part about the same. Ends with fresh breeze the Bark with all sail out. Saw a Bark Steering to the Westward.
Lat 33.18° Long 29.06 E

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Sunday July 31st 1864 This day Comes in with N. E. winds & Cloudy weather Steering W. by N. Middle part light winds & rain squalls. Ends with fresh westerly winds. Saw nothing at 7 AM took in the light sails & double reefed the fore topsail
Lat 33.00° Long 27.28 E

Monday August 1st Comes in with fresh Westerly gales and heavy Sea the Bark under close reefed topsails & reefed foresail Middle part much the same ends with better weather at 4 P.M. Saw the land 25 miles Dist three vessels in sight
Lat 33.46° Long 27.20 E

Tuesday Aug 2^d Comes in with fine weather and a Calm. Middle part rainy Ends with fine weather. three vessels in sight the land in sight 25 miles Dist
Lat 34.13° Long 26.40 E

Wednesday Aug 3^d This day Comes in with moderate & westerly winds. The Bark making short tacks working to windward. Cape St. Francis in sight bearing N. by E. 18 miles. three other vessels in sight
Lat 34.16° Long 26.00 E

Thursday Aug 4th Comes in with dead Calm. Middle part the same latter part a moderate breeze from N. E. Steering W. by N. Middle part
Lat 34.42° Long 23.29 E

Friday Aug 5th Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the Westward the Bark on different tacks working to windward. repaired the old foresail and bent it. Three vessels in sight.
Lat 34.25° Long 23.48 E
