

Bark Sea Fox Homeward bound.

Wednesday Aug 17th 1864 These twenty four hours light trades. The Course N. N. W. Saw finbacks. one sail passed us steering same Course. The watch employed on Ship's duty. Cooper planing the decks
Lat 25.30° Long 5.07 E

Thursday Aug 18th Comes in with a light breeze from south Course N. N. W. Middle part Calm. latter part light air. Two vessels in sight. The watch employed planing decks & working in the rigging
Lat 24.25° Long 4.06 E

Friday Aug 19th Comes in with a dead Calm and continues so through the twenty four hours. Several vessels in sight as the same predicament
Lat 24.20°

Saturday Aug 20th This day light winds & Calms which continues so through the day. Seven vessels in sight. all of them becalmed
Lat 24.00° Long 3.45 E

Sunday Aug 21st Comes in with light air from the S. E. Middle and latter part moderate trades. Ends with a good breeze three vessels in sight
Lat 22.50° Long 2.10 E

Monday Aug 22nd Comes in with fine weather and light trades for Bark steering N. W. by N. & N. Middle and latter part fresh trades three vessels in sight
Lat 21.20° Long 0.15 W.

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Tuesday Aug 23rd 1864. Comes in with fresh trades & squally weather the Course N. N. W. the weather continues about the same throughout the twenty four hours. one vessel in sight
Lat 19.36° Long 2.10 W.

Wednesday Aug 24th Comes in with a fine breeze and steady trades steering N. by W. Middle part about the same. Spoke a Dutch Bark from Batavia bound to Amsterdam
Lat 17.50° Long 4.30 W.

Thursday Aug 25th Comes in with light trades steering N. W. by N. & N. at daylight saw the Island of St Helena bearing S. E. 12 miles one vessel in sight. made a main top sail Studding sail
Lat 16.18° Long 6.01 W.

Friday Aug 26th These twenty four hours a fresh breeze & steady trades for Bark steering N. W. by N. & N. Saw a shoal of Porpoises. Employed clearing the iron work inside and painting it.
Lat 14.53° Long 8.10 W.

Saturday Aug 27th This day fine weather and steady trades. steering N. N. W. continues about the same through the twenty four hours. Saw a few finbacks. Ends with steady breezes unbut the Gaff to repair for a lower Studding sail
No obs.

Sunday Aug 28th Comes in with steady trades the Bark steering N. N. W. Middle part light. Saw a few finbacks. Ends with moderate trades.
Lat 12.16° Long 11.40 W.
