Thursday Sept 22nd 1864. Comes in with fresh trade. The Bark Steering N.W. The wind continues steady throughout the twenty four hours saw nothing, finished painting inside.

Friday Sept 23rd This day fine weather and light trades. The Course N.W. Middle & latter part about the same.

Lat 20.36^N Long 53.24^W
Lunar 53.24^W

Saturday Sept 24th Comes in with very light trades. The Course N.W. Middle & latter part light trades. Spoke the British Schooner Dasher 20 days from Halifax bound to Trinidad in the off.

Lat 21.40^N Long 54.40^W

Sunday Sept 25th Comes in with light air from the North. Steering by the wind to the N.W. Ends with Calms.

Lat 22.10^N Long 54.50^W

Monday Sept 26th This day Comes in with a dead Calm and continues so throughout the twenty four hours saw nothing.

No obs.

Tuesday Sept 27th These twenty four hours light airs and Calms. Employed painting & cleaning iron work. Saw blackbirds and flowers for them without success.

Ends with a light breeze from the N.E. No obs.

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Wednesday Sept 28th Comes in with light breezes from N.E. Steering N.W. Middle & latter part about the same. Ends with moderate trades. Saw nothing.

Lat 22.30^N Long 56.42^W

Thursday Sept 29th Comes in with light air from N.E. The Course N.W. Middle & latter part Calm. Spoke the Bark Ellen Morrisson 16 days from New York to Barbados.

Lat 23.23^N Long 57.47^W

Friday Sept 30th This day light winds from N.E. Steering N.W. Middle & latter part nearly Calm. Saw nothing. picked up a Studding sail yards.

Lat 24.00^N Long 58.00^W

Saturday Oct 1st Comes in with light winds from N.E. Steering N.W. Middle & latter part quite moderate. Saw nothing. Ends with rain & squalls.

Lat 24.35^N Long 58.50^W

Sunday Oct 2nd This day light trades and fine weather. Steering N.W. Saw nothing of importance. One man sick with dysentery.

Lat 25.27^N Long 60.15^W

Monday Oct 3rd This day Comes in with light trades. The Course N.W. Middle & latter part Calm. Ends with light winds from the N.W. Saw nothing.

Lat 26.00^N Long 61.00^W

Tuesday Oct 4th This day Comes in with moderate breeze from N.W. The Bark on the Northern tack by the wind. Middle and latter part rainy and squally. Ends with bad weather. The Bark under close reef. No obs.
