

Bark Sea Fox Homeward bound

Sunday Oct 16th Comes in with light breeze from S.W. Steering S.W. at 10 A.M. Saw Sperm Whales going to the Westward. Lowered for them, and Struck to the Starboard Boat and saved a small whale took him alongside and cut him in finished about 5 P.M. latter part fresh gale from S.W. Several vessels in sight. Lat 39 18 N Long 69 57

Monday Oct 17th Comes in with fresh S.W. gales The Bark by the wind standing to the Northward. Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing but vessels. Lat 40 34 N Long 70 34 W

Tuesday Oct 18th Comes in with moderate breezes from S.W. The Bark Steering by the wind to the S.W. completed Hoisting a small Whale finished about dark. Made Hook Island about 6 P.M. at Midnight threw the tryworks overboard Hook Island bearing S.W. 20 miles

Wednesday Oct 19th Comes in with a fresh breeze from S.W. Steering by the wind to the S.W. Saw war Steamer, at 9 A.M. took a pilot off Cuttyhunk and stood up the Bay with a leading wind and So ends our long voyage
