

Pargu Sea Ranger Cpt Allen

Monday June 3rd 1867

Sat 36.05.2. Long 7.42. A moderate breeze steering E. The very pleasant weather Mid part Shorten sail running over the ground slowly in hopes to raise a fellow in the morn lat part at 8 A.M. made sail steering E.S.E. Surf odd jobs weather thick & rainy saw a Finback & a few birds

Tuesday Jan 4th 1867

Sat 36.09

Long 7.42. Moderate breeze steering E.S.E. Finbacks & Porpoises around Mid part strong breeze from E.M. steering E.S.E. lat part at 5 P.M. raised several large sperm whales lowered three Larbone Boats & Main Boat struck one which we soon succeeded in killing. Took along side. Mast Boat got stuck & was put away upon the house for repairs. Another one fitted & put upon the crains in its place.

Wednesday Jan 5th 1867

Sat 34.05.8

Long 7.58. Mid part cutting at about 4 P.M. Mid part standing Boats crew watches lat part called all hands at 4 A.M. started cutting pork breeze & raged to ends (Thursday Jan 6th)

Sat 34.47.0

Long 8.42.6. Some strong breeze & rough finisher cutting at 7 P.M. Mid part started the works & cutting up blubber Sat part clearing up Case &c

Friday Jan 7th

Sat 34.52.2 Long 8.41.6 Fine weather & light breeze engaged cutting up junk Boiling &c. Mid part Boiling Fine weather & quite smooth light breeze - Sat Jan 8th

Sat 35.01.0

Long 8.59.6. Corn with a Calm Boiling &c. Mid part calm boiling Sat part moderate breeze Boiling

Sun Jan 9th

Sat 35.54.0 Corn with a fresh breeze cloudy with some rain Boiling Mid part finished Boiling considerable rain ship in clearing up deck & latter part day in clearing decks slight breeze

Sat 35.58.2

Monday Jan 10th Long 7.22.6. Good breeze heading from N.W. to W. Mid part under port sail Sat part strong breeze Cryed stowing down & ends this day

Sat 35.58.2

Tuesday Jan 11th Long 7.00.6. Strong breeze with a heavy sea cry in stowing down Mid part fresh breeze lat part raised a large sperm whale about 11 A.M. going to windward. Surf breaking out to ends

Sat 35.43.8

Wednesday Jan 12th Long 7.25.6. Strong breeze with stowing off Mid part ship came to the wind heading North Sat part light breeze with heavy swell to ends

Sat 35.13.5

Thursday Jan 13th Light breeze heading N.E. & W. Long 6.35.6. Ship at 10 P.M. also at 4 A.M. Sat part moderate breeze steering E.S.E. thick haze weather various jobs to ends this 24 hours

Sat 35.13.5

Friday Jan 14th Long 6.25.6. Moderate breeze steering N.E. & W. Mid part Shorten sail hang to the wind on starboard tack heading E.S.E. Mid part light breeze at 10 P.M. corn ship Sat part light breeze from the N.E.

Sat 35.08.8

Sat Jan 15th (saw a steamer) Long 6.45.6. Corn with light breeze from Eastward. Long 6.45.6. very pleasant weather one in sight engaged various jobs Mid part calm & light airs up to 4 P.M. when it began to breeze at 5.30 A.M. saw a large sperm whale off our bow dis. sails Sat part lowered down whale started to windward & we came on board hoisted the Boats crew working ship to windward with strong breeze

Sat 35.28.3

Sunday Jan 16th Long 7.25.6. Corn with a good breeze at 3 P.M. lowered again about sunset struck the whale & Boat but the jowls drew & were obliged to come on board with Disheveled luck & very sadly disappointed. a very large whale. Mid part steering E.S.E. until 12 P.M. when we came to the wind upon Port tack & hauled off & got atack at 4 A.M. steamed S. good breeze from N.E. & W. steering E.S.E. & W. saw a few Dolphins also two thump back whales & several

Sat 35.28.3
