Sat 37. 29 Monday Jan 31st Long 12. 25 Fine weather wind about N.E. a light breeze & swell steering S.E. a plenty of Britt in sight. Emp. working N.E. music at 7 P.M. from the Melodion & some music & singing. Mid part very moderate. Sat part do saw lots of Finbacks. Emp. music stretching the foretop gal sail & various other jobs.

Sat 37. 48 Long 19. 12 Tuesday Feb 1st Corn calm weather beautiful saw lots of Finbacks emp. stretching the foretop gal sail & the main top gal sail. 7 P.M. music & singing at 5 P.M. but the foretop gal sail mid part very moderate. Sat part do sent down the main top gal sail for Melodion stitching. Calm emp. stitching. Main top gal sail raising new boat falls tapping the rigging & various other jobs. Wednesday Feb 2nd

Sat 37. 11 Long 21. 50 Corn calm emp. do at 2 P.M. came to buoy up from steering. but the main top gal sail saw a Finback & Curlew. Sat 37. 33 at 7 P.M. strong breeze squally with some rain took in all light sails but top gal sails. Mid part more moderate. Sat all sail again. Sat part fine weather strong breeze from West steering S.E. employees various jobs about deck by Thomas that fillow board. returned to duty again. As ends strong breeze fine weather.

Sat 38. 48 Thursday Feb 3rd Long 26. 08 Corn strong breeze from N.E. W. & canting all the time steering S.E. by E. emp. various jobs at 7 P.M. saw a school of very large Blackfish & also some Boomerangs took in light sails wind increasing & S.E. heading S.E. Sat 38. 31 Boomerangs about 4 lat part the same wind still continuing emp. doing nothing particular.

Sat 39. 17 Bround to New Zealand

Friday Feb 4th

A strong breeze from S.E. heading E. at 7.30 P.M. were ship heading S.E. at 11 P.M. heading S.E. a heavy sea. Sat part strong breeze heading S.E. by E. emp. breaking out for provisions & water.

Sat 39. 49 Long 30. 08 Moderate breeze from the East. steering S.E. a heavy swell right in her running saw plenty of Right Whale feed. Britt & a Dolphin. Sat part the same emp. repairing the foremast.

Sat 40. 14 Long 32. 38 Saturday Feb 5th A light breeze from the N.E. steering S.E. by E. but the fore sail saw and lowered for a large school of Blackfish. Bought 5 Mate 2 see Mate 1. Thimble & Fork mate 1 apiece. Mid part and Sat part cutting them up finished & washed off decks at 8 O.C. A.M. a light breeze from E.C.

Sat 40. 31 Long 32. 28 Sunday Feb 6th Corn with a light breeze from E.C. steering S.E. by E. at between 7 & 9 O.C. P.M. sacred music & singing. Mid part good breeze from N.E. by E. Sat part wind hauled to the S.W. blowing quite fresh under double reefed topsails steering S.E. by E.

Sat 41. 33 Long 37. 50 Tuesday Feb 8th Fresh breeze from S.W. steering S.E. considerable rain. Mid & Sat part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering S.E. by E. sampled in minding the Blackfish. Wednesday Feb 9th

Sat 41. 48 Long 42. 39 Good breeze from the S.W. steering S.E. by E. various employment. Mid & later part the same. Emp. hauling Blackfish.

Sat 42. 28 Long 43. 29 Thursday Feb 10th Tipped ship wind hauled to S.E. heading S.W. at 4 P.M. finished boiling. Mid part strong breeze heading S.W. by W. Sat part do emp. various jobs. Sat 43. 04 Long 44. 12 Friday Feb 11th

Corn wind S.E. heading S.W. quite calm. Emp. various jobs about deck plenty of Finbacks & Porpoises. Sat 43. 59 Long 46. 30 Sat Feb 12th

Corn good breeze heading S. & S.E. Mid & lat part the same saw a school of Penguin which are like maniacs. Sat 44. 29 Long 49. 47 Sunday Feb 13th

Corn a very light breeze from Eastward heading S. & S.E. emp. washing clothes. A plenty of Finbacks in abundance saw in hopes to see Johnny. Caught whale soon as we heard a fair wind for New Zealand. Mid & lat part the same.
