Mid part strong breeze took in Soft Top sail & spander Sat part under increasing took in Top Gal sails double reefed Top sail frigate jib weather thick & rainy at 9 A.M. wind hardened & moderate Sat Top Gal sails & jib saw plenty of Kerguelen & Right Whale birds but no right whales

Sat 47. 01 Long 53. 00 Tue Oct 15th

Came with a light breeze N.E. steering S.E. by S. under all sail mid part at 11 P.M. some heaving up at 6 A.M. ship under double reefed Main top sail and Foremast staysail blowing a gale Sat part moderate a little so set the Foresail & Foretop sail double reefed main top sail single reefed steering S.E. wind N.W.

Wednesday Feb 16th

Came with a gale from N.E. steering S.E. by E. at 1 P.M. double reefed Main top sail a very heavy sea & a very strong breeze at 3 P.M. lost the stanchion boat & all the paraphernalia belonging to her at 4.00 took in Foresail Foretop sail Foretop & Main top sail sat the Main spencer & came to the wind heading N.E. Sat part took mid part a very heavy gale a heavy sea running at 11 P.M. shipped a sea & some in the ship light quite a quantity of water run down the cabin Sat part under a little the ocean is all a feather white

Sunday Feb 20th

Sat 49. 03 Long 53. 52 Fresh breeze from the North steering East very cloudy & overcast Mid part strong breeze took in Royals Fore Top gal sail Soft top sail Sat part took in Main top sail Sat sail Soft jib & sails

Sat 49. 45 Long 57. 18 Monday Feb 21st
Came squally cloudy wind N. steering East at 6 P.M. took in the jib & double reefed Foretop sail took in sparker Mid part do Sat part at 12 M. wind shifted to the N. moderate so ends this day

Tue Feb 22nd

Came moderate wind N. at 6 P.M. came to the wind heading N.W. Mid part calm Sat part at 6 am wind began to breeze from S.E. at 12 M. saw the Island St Pauls bearing E.N.E. 15 mls distant so ends

Sat 49. 56 Long 59. 09

Tuesday Feb 23rd

Came wind N.E. St Pauls in sight at 10 A.M. ship ran on at 4 P.M. came to breeze up fresh weather thick & rainy at 7 P.M. wind N.E. heading S.E. The contemplated a fishing cruise around the Island but the wind not being favorable we were disappointed Sat part fresh breeze from the N.W. steering S.E. some rain so ends

Sat 50. 01 Long 59. 00

Thursday Feb 24th

Came with a fresh breeze from the N.W. steering S.E. Mid part wind changed to the N. Sat part fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.E. by E. so ends

Sat 50. 56 Long 59. 11

Friday Feb 25th

Came fresh breeze from the N.W. steering S.E. by E. all sail set at 7 P.M. took in the Royals & light staysail & c Mid part squally with rain Sat part do

Sat 51. 33 Long 59. 52

Sat Feb 26th

Squally with rain all sail set at 7 P.M. took in the light sails wind N.W. Mid & Sat part the same so ends this 24 hours

Sat 51. 40 Long 56. 42

Sunday Feb 27th

Continued squally wind N.W. steering S.E. by E. at 7 P.M. double reefed Top sail Mid part squally with rain Sat part better weather wind N.W. a very strong breeze & heavy sea hauled back & shifted the mast back to the stanchion cranes for repair keeping so ends this day
