Spat 3306 Long 16112 Week 24th
Strong breeze from E. S. E. heading N. E. thick
A foggy with some rain under double reefed
top sails Mid part Mid & lat part the
same shook the reef out the Main top sail
& foretop sail set the Main top galsail at 5 P. M. saw
white water at 37.53 Long 160.33 Friday March 25th

Corn round C. S. E. heading N. E. by N. at 4.5 P. M.
saw white water & points off lea bow kept off point
it coming on dark saw no more of it shortened sail
for the night under double reefed topsails came to the
wind heading S. E. by N. We are now on Mid ground
Mid part good breeze fine weather at 12 M. wore ship
heading S. E. by E. set part fine main all sail steering
S. E. by W. ship setting up Mizzen top backstay & backing out
for Broomson to ends this day Sat 3307 Long 160.33

Sat March 26th
Corn fine weather strong breeze from E. N. E. steering
N. N. W. Mid & lat part the same Sat 36.33 Long 160.15

Sunday March 27th
Corn more moderate
Sat 36.28 Long 161.33 Corn squally double reefed
topsails saw one Porpoise at 4 P. M. upon most
erect set chaintop gal & wind light from North
heading S. N. E. muzzed this evening from N. W. &
Flute Mid and latter part steering S. N. E.

Monday Week 28th
A good breeze from the Northward heading E. N. E.
Mid part the same lat part good breeze fine weather
wind S. N. E. by E.

Tuesday March 29th
Strong breeze from N. W. steering N. N. W. by W.
one finback in sight Mid good breeze lat part
do squally with rain

Wednesday Week 30th Sat 32.55
Corn squally rainy weather Long 160.48
at 5 P. M. about hauled to hauled
aback Main yard & shuple old Bow boat for a new
one putting old bow boat upon house in place
of another one for St. boat crains in place
of the one lost off Dorelaton Mid part heavy rain
lat part do saw a few Albione

Pacific Ocean Outward bound

April 1st
Sat 32.55 Long 160.48 Thursday Week 31st
Corn calm fine weather but no whales
at 5 P. M. light breeze from the South steering
N. by E. Albione & dancing this evening Mid &
Lat part Moderate breeze

Friday April 1st 1879
Sat 33.05 Long 171.35
A good breeze from the Southward steering E.
Duff reaching off Low rigging & paraville & Bow
Boat blue bottom black Whistle struck & high
part squally from South steering E. double
reefed foretop sail lat part do Main Top sail
quite a heavy sea running Eup fitting
the aft new boat & so ends strong breeze
Sat March April 2nd

Corn strong breeze from a heavy sea
saw one Finback at 4 P. M. took in foretop sail
Eup fitting aft new boat Mid part strong breeze
steering by the wind on starboard tack heading S. N. E.
part part moderated set foretop sail Main top sail &
Main top galsail Eup fitting aft boat saw some
Albione broke out for water Sunday April 3rd

Monday April 4th
Corn good breeze from Southward
steering S. E. all sail set Eup fitting aft boat Muzzed
& dancing this evening Mid part light breeze at 2 A. M.
heave aback for water at 5 A. M. made all sail strong
& saw Albione flying fish nothing more a good breeze

Tuesday April 5th
Corn with strong breeze from S. E. or steering
& saw Albione Mid part shortened sail lat part
course S. E. pleasant weather

Wednesday April 6th
A strong breeze from the S. course S. E.
at 6 P. M. shortened sail Mid part course S. E. by E.
Lat part at 7.30 saw white water & buffere to the
course with heads yet aback promise to be nothing
of any consequence to us so brace forward & stoove
along by the wind at 8 A. M. raised a sail at 9 A. M.
wore ship Calvary breeze Sat 33.23 Long 172.40

Thursday April 7th
Strong breeze from S. E. heading S. W. at 4.30 wore ship
heading E. one sail in sight - all it - a whaler Mid &
Lat part the same Thus ends this 24 hours
Sail etc. Sail etc.
