Lat 30.30 Long 179.30
A good breeze from the Westward steering North. Wind part sailing with main & aback Sat part steering N.W. by E. & E. so ends this 24 hours

Thursday April 28th
Good breeze from the Westward & Cortis Rocks in sight right ahead at 4.30 left off for Sat part steering N.W. by E. at 6 O'clock

Friday April 29th
Good breeze from the South steering E. at 4.30 left off N.W. by E. Cortis Rocks bearing N.W. by E. distant 10 miles Goat Island bearing N.W. by E. distant 12 miles Wind part sailing under short sail on Western tack Sat part do a very strong breeze no men at mast heads & land not in sight

Saturday April 30th
Come with a young gale being thing foiled but double reefed Main topsail quite a number of birds around Wind part strong breeze all well Sat part one sail



Strong breeze from the Eastward steering N.W. by E. gamming with Bargee Kefelore & Bargee Peter 34 months from home with 48 lbs all the shore part equally with rain Sat part strong breeze steering S.W. by E. & E. & sail

Wind S.W. by E. Cruise Wind part shortened sail Sat part strong breeze & squally with some rain Lat 32.50 Long 179.15 A strong breeze from Eastward steering Westward under short sail plenty of rain. Wind part calm short breeze sail to double reefed Main topsail fine weather Sat part fine weather light breeze two sails Gamming Bargee Coral Cpt. Potter 20 months out 16 lbs all to be 100 humpback



Monday May 2nd Lat 33.52 Long 179.52 till gamming Coral strong breeze good weather since & Southward on starboard tack since part at 9 O'clock finished gamming shortened sail again & aback Sat part fine weather Coral in sight & made all sail spread chances since & steering N.W. by E.

Tuesday May 3rd Lat 32.54 Long 179.36 Commences a light breeze from the North steering N.W. & a squall at 6 A.M. gamming B.K. Coral at 9 P.M. finished gamming Sat part Wind S.W. by E. steering N.W. by E. in company with Bargee Coral 33.55
