the Bay Lat part do strong breeze some rain two sails

Wednesday June 5<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a strong breeze some rain off and on the Bay, at sunset Lat part bearing N.W. & dis 20 miles Mid part lying off and on Wind North squally with some rain Lat part do off and on

Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup>

Weather continues much the same at 3.30 P.M. wind changed to S.W. good weather Mid part off and on the coast in the vicinity of the Bay Lat part working up the Bay squally some rain

Friday June 7<sup>th</sup>

Arrived off the town about 2.30 P.M. Capt went on shore. He paid the Borquo Calas Lira Lat Europa and Albion lying here. at 4.30 P.M. Capt returned bringing letters. the runaways have escaped. He immediately squared away bidding farewell to the town of Kilsall for some months at least Mid part also Lat part strong breeze from the S.W. steering N.W.E.

Sat June 8<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from the S.W. steering N.W.E. Mid part the same Lat part more moderate

Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from the S.W. steering N.W.E. by N. Mid part light breeze from the Northward heading N.E. by E. and S.W. Lat part good breeze heading N.E.

Monday June 10<sup>th</sup>

Good breeze from the N.W. heading N.W.E. Saw Finbacks Mid part at 2 A.M. wore ship and came to the coast with main yard aback heading N.W. Lat part steering N.W.E. engaged in trawling out for crabs

Tuesday June 11<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from S.W. steering N.W.E. and N. Heavy swell from the N. Mid part also Lat part light breeze

Wednesday June 12<sup>th</sup>

Sat 29. 42. 17. 2.5 6 W

Spinn whales in sight

Spinn down & followed up the shore until darkness compelled us to return to the ship Mid part light breeze wind with main yard aback Lat part light breeze several Finbacks in sight so ends this day

Thursday June 15<sup>th</sup>

A light breeze from the North and heading to the Eastward several finbacks in sight at sunset Lat part at 2 A.M. sprang up a good breeze Mid part also saw plenty of finbacks working ship towards Lat part in sight being eastward Finbacks in abundance

Friday June 17<sup>th</sup>

Wind S.W. steering N.W.E. a good breeze at sunset came to the wind and shortened sail. Finbacks in sight Mid part main yard aback Lat part good breeze steering E.

Sat June 18<sup>th</sup>

Good breeze from S.W. steering N.W.E. by N. the Island of Sunday in sight at sunset came to the wind and shortened sail Mid part some thunder and lightning also an occasional squall of rain Lat part steering N.W.E. strong breeze

Sunday June 19<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from the Northward and squally steering N.W.E. Mid part under short sail heading to under short sail squalls are frequent Mid part at 2 A.M. wore ship heading S.W. by E. at daylight made sail steering N.W. & strong breeze from S.W. Lat part

The weather continues the same steering N.W. saw Finbacks Mid part the same steering N.W. by E. Lat part the same saw one finback

Lat 26. 10. 3. Long 174. 10. 3. Thursday June 21<sup>st</sup>  
Another continues the same wind S.W. steering N.W. by E. at sundown shortened sail to double reefed Top sails wore ship and stood to Westward a heavy sea and strong breeze Mid part more moderate heading N. Lat part the same made sail at day-light

Lat 26. 10. 3. Long 174. 10. 3. Friday June 22

A good breeze on starboard tack by the wind saw a school of Porpoises going quick to N.W. Mid part under short sail with main yard aback Lat part steering N.W. squally weather

Good breeze from S.W. steering N.W. Mid & Lat part fine breeze
