Wednesday Nov 2nd

Slight winds from S.W. Mid and Lat part
beautiful weather light breeze and calms.

Thursday Nov 3rd

Very pleasant weather slight breeze from S.W.
steering Southward Mid and Lat part wind
light saw finbacks

Friday Nov 4th

A fine breeze from N.E. steering South saw
finbacks and a Sperm whale Mid and Lat part
moderate

Saturday 5th

Slight winds from the N.W. on the port tack carrying
all sail saw Grampuses and Finbacks

Sunday Nov 6th

Slight winds from the N.W. on the port tack
and under all sail Mid and Lat part baffling
winds and calms

Monday Nov 7th

Splendid weather winds light and calms
Saw Grampuses mid part light air and calms
Lat part saw a large sperm whale raised by Capt
Lat 35.07 S. Tuesday Nov 8th Long 177. 20 E

Spurred and con chasing continued the chase
until darkness compelled us to return on board
winds very light from the E.S.E. Mid
part calm lying with main yard aback
whale when Lat men going very slow to S.W.
Lat part calm saw a few Grampuses but
no whale in sight the water is full of squalls

Wednesday Nov 9th

Fine weather light breeze and calms Mid
and Lat part the same saw Grampuses and
Porpoises and Skippacks and Sperm whales in abundance

Thursday Nov 10th

Calms and light winds Grampuses in sight. Mid
and Lat part moderate breeze from the North saw a
Skippack

Friday Nov 11th

Moderate breeze from the North by the wind on the
starboard tack Mid part the same Lat part squally
some rain

Cruising in South of Norfolk Island

Saturday Nov 12th

Weather continues squally wind from North by the
wind on starboard tack at sundown shortened
sail to double reefed foretop sail and whole main
Mid part the same Lat part ditto

Sunday Nov 13th

Very pleasant moderate breeze from the S.E. steering
N. two sails in sight a Barque & Brig. also saw a
Skippack employed in repairing the foretop sail
Mid part same Lat part pleasant

Monday Nov 14th

Pleasant weather Moderate breeze from S.E. steering
N.W. saw Grampuses Mid and Lat part the same

Tuesday Nov 15th

Cloudy light breeze from the Eastward steering North
Mid part the same Lat part do

Wednesday Nov 16th

Came with strong breeze from E.S.E. steering North
garnished with Barque Camelline Capt. Fordham
to windward with two hundred lbs
Mid and Lat part strong breeze and foggy



Thursday Nov 17th

Moderate weather spoke Barque Onward
of Sydney Mid part garnished with Onward Lat part
off and on Norfolk Island Capt. Adams employed
rafting off water the Napoleon Capt. Fuller is
ing off and in company with us also Barque
Onward

Fine weather employed rafting off water took
one hundred lbs this P.M. and stowed down

Sat 19th Sunday 20th Monday 21st

Saying off and on Norfolk Island recruiting ship Lat 22. 20 S
Long 167. 05 E

Tuesday 22nd

Took our departure from Norfolk Island this P.M. Lat
two men by destination a Boatman and Foreman from
Mid part experienced quite a heavy tempest. Lat part
saw a large school of sperm whales and were fortunate
enough to capture one very bad weather very much
thick and foggy
