 part under short sail. Strong breeze Spat part ditto

Sunday Jan 22^d
 A strong breeze from the Eastward on the southern
 tack. Mid and Spat part on the northern tack
 One sail in sight.

Monday Jan 23^d
 (Sail H) Strong breeze from the Eastward on the north-
 ern tack. One sail in sight. Mid part room ship and
 stood to southward. Spat part room ship by the
 round on northern tack. Fine weather made all sail

Tuesday Jan 24th
 Very pleasant good breeze from the Eastward on the
 northern tack. Mid part from Breeze Olga Capt. Moore
 750 spurs all told. Under short sail. Spat
 part made all sail on the southern tack

Wednesday Jan 25th
 Very pleasant good breeze from the East
 on the southern tack at 4 P.M. tacked ship.
 Two sails in sight. Mid part under short sail
 Spat part cruising. Two sails.

Thursday Jan 26th
 Fine weather and good breeze from the E. Mid
 part under short sail. Spat part made sail good
 weather one sail in sight. Cruising (Sail H)

Friday Jan 27th
 Fine weather strong breeze cruising one sail in
 sight. Mid and Spat part the same wind from the East

Saturday Jan 28th
 Moderate breeze from the Eastward two sails in sight
 Mid and Spat part same fine weather (Sail H)

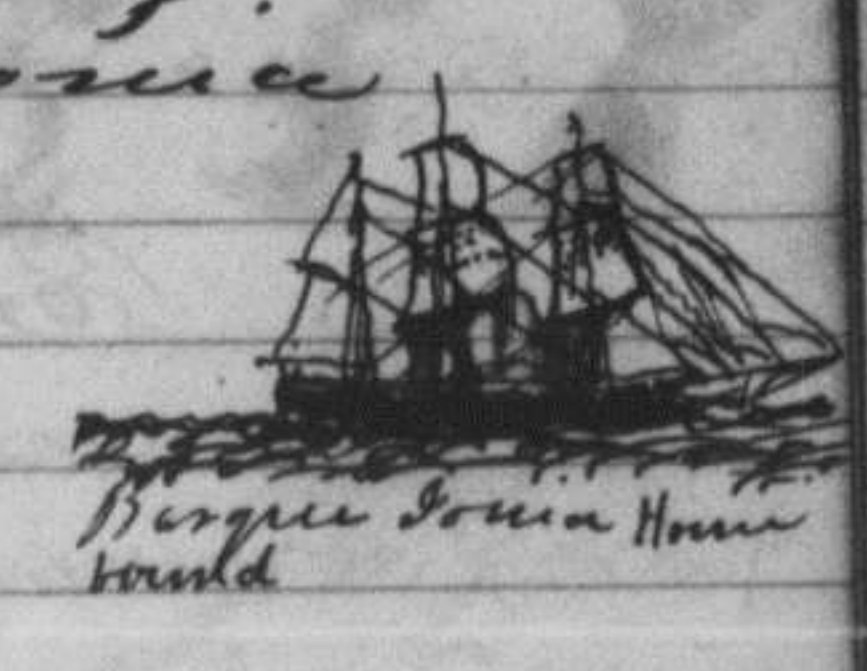
Sunday Jan 29th

 and Spat part calm saw Killers

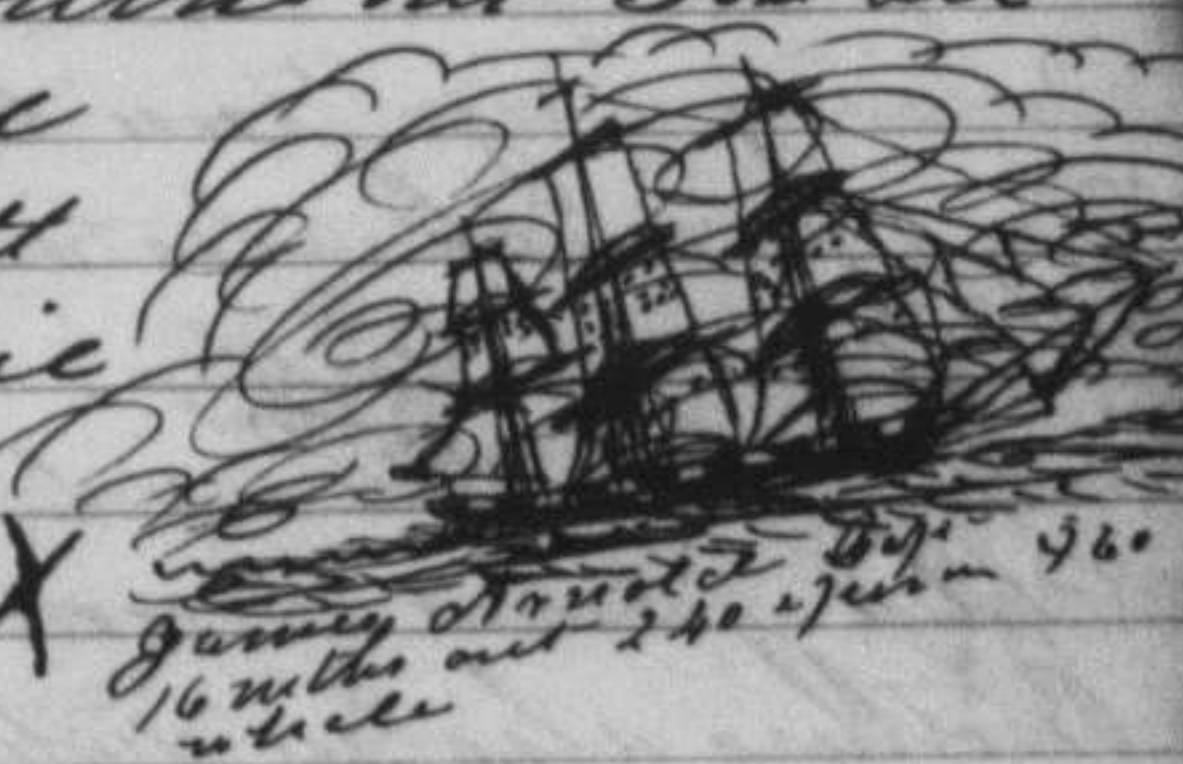


Tuesday Jan 31st
 Splendid weather with a moderate breeze from the
 Westward steering S.E. Mid and Spat part the
 same strong school of large spurs in holes going
 quick to midward. Lobster and chace them
 a few hours Wednesday Feb 1st

 and Spat part calm One sail in sight

Thursday Feb 2^d
 Very good weather Calm. one sail in sight
 Mid part sprang up a good breeze from N.E. W.
 Spat part the same. One sail in sight.

Friday Feb 3^d
 Com. with a good breeze from Westward. spoke ship
 James Arnold Capt. Briggs 16 months out 300 all
 told. he has wife on board employed
 gunning. some rain. at sunset
 finished gunning & shot some sea
 Mice and Spat part strong breeze
 James Arnold in sight



Saturday Feb 4th
 Spat part strong breeze from S.W. heading N.E. W. under
 double reefed topsails one sail in sight. Mid part same
 rain Spat part whole sail breeze saw a large beach

Sunday Feb 5th
 This day and fine with wind from Westward steering
 N.W. and S.W. Albion the Killers the light B.
 Mid part at 12 midnight came to anchor on southern tack
 with head up about very moderate Spat part very moderate
 made all sail Albion and Effish around

Monday Feb 6th
 Beautiful weather and light breeze from the Westward
 steering S.E. saw Breeze Mid and Spat part calm One sail in sight
