somewhat foggy so ends.

Wednesday Nov 29th Lat 30° 17'
Foggy by squalls. Wind light from E.S. saw
white water. Wind part the same. Lat part de
wind so ends.

Thursday Nov 30th
Moderate breeze from the Eastward. Wind and Lat part
rainy. Wind changeable so ends.

Friday Dec 1st
Fresh breeze from Southward. Some rain.
Wind wind fresh. Lat part spoke the Barque
Esmeralda Goddard 500 all told so ends.

Saturday Dec 2nd
Strong breeze from the N.E. sailing the former bar
Lat part and Lat weather de so ends.

Sat Dec 10th

Sun Dec 11th

air from the North so ends.

Dec 12th
Pleasant and light air from the Northward. Wind part
same. Lat part Norfolk Island in sight bearing N by E
dis 30 miles also 3 sails in sight so ends.

Tuesday Dec 13th
Pleasant and good breeze from N.E. ward Norfolk Island
bearing distant 18 miles at sunset. Wind and Lat part
fine so ends. Wednesday Dec 14th

Pleasant light air from Northward. Two sails. Spoke the
Barque "Hucia" of Sydney bound to the Solomon
Islands. Lat bearing N.E. dis 5 miles at sunset.

Wind part calm. Lat part light breeze. Capt boat on
shore so ends. Friday Dec 15th

Beautiful weather. Employees getting off water
1000 lbs. Wind part. Boats and watch on shore. Lat part
laying off and on showing down water. One sail in
sight the Bark Janet Capt Waver. Also two ships laying
at anchor off Norfolk Island so ends.
