Saw part same with a strong breeze from E.
One sail in sight so ends.

Tues. Mch. 19th

Strong breeze. Wind pleasant weather. Wind
E. Repairing the Mainmast. Two sails in sight.
Wind part equally. Saw part good weather
fine breeze two sails so ends.

Wed. Mch. 20th

Weather fine. Wind E. Eastly. Finishing and
beat Mainmast. Also worked and repaired
Mainmast. One sail in sight so ends. Wind part
same. Saw part one sail in sight so ends.

Thurs. Mch. 21st

Fine weather. One strong breeze from E. S. E.
One sail in sight. at sunset shortened sail.
Wind part same. Saw part do. One sail in sight.

Friday Mch. 22nd

Weather continues fine with wind
still from the Eastward at 3.30 P.M.
spoke Barque Eliza Captain Simon
31 months out. 16.50 all told at sunset.
Finished gaming at 10.30 P.M. Wind and
Saw part weather continues the same.
Saw a school of Porpoises. One sail
in sight so ends strong breeze.

Sat. Mch. 23rd

Strong breeze heading to the Southward
under double reefed topsails. Wind part pleasant
Saw part strong breeze so ends.

Sun. Mch. 24th

Strong breeze heading to the Southward under double
reefed topsails. At 2 P.M. saw three large whales
close to the ship. One came and succeeded in hitting one
took him along side at sunset. W.B. stone. Wind part
pleasant getting ready to cut. Saw part cutting.
Pleasant weather so ends.

Mon. Mch. 25th

Pleasant weather. Cutting. Wind part Boiling. Saw
part finished cutting. Spoke the "Coast" of St. George's
Capt Porter so ends. Weather pleasant.

Tues. Mch. 26th

Boiling and clearing up the decks. Wind part pleasant
Saw part same. "Boiling" one sail in sight so ends.

Wed. Mch. 27th

Pleasant and moderate weather. "Boiling" Wind
part same. Saw part pleasant "Boiling" so ends.

Thursday Mch. 28th

Pleasant weather "Boiling" Wind part same.
Saw part very pleasant weather "Boiling" so ends.

Fri. Mch. 29th

Pleasant weather "Boiling" Wind part same. Saw
part finished "Boiling" pleasant weather strong breeze.

Sat. Mch. 30th

Pleasant weather strong breeze. Wind part pleasant
Saw part strong breeze so ends.

Sun. Mch. 31st

Pleasant weather strong breeze and morning ship
Wind part same. Saw part very pleasant. Two sails
in sight. Cape Brett 20 miles off so ends.

Mon. April 1st

Pleasant weather with light E. wind. Breeze into
the Bay. At 7.30 P.M. came to anchor in the harbor
of "Burrell" We found at anchor here. The Hunter.
Lydia. James Arnold. Adeline. Willmore. And
Jenny.

Tues. Apr. 2nd

Boiled from the port of "Burrell". This P.M. leaving
in part the ship Adeline. James Arnold. And
Naomi. And Barque Thos. Brothers. Lydia. Eliza.
Alben Barker. And Alaska. Wind part somewhat
special. strong breeze. Saw part the same. so ends.

Wed. Apr. 3rd

Strong breeze from the Southward strong E. S. E.
Wind part lying to under short sail. Saw part
strong breeze.

Thurs. Apr. 4th

Strong breeze course N. E. by E. Wind part under short
sail. Saw part moderate weather so ends.

Fri. Apr. 5th

Strong equally weather same in abundance. Wind part
weather growing better. Saw part fine so ends.

Sat. Apr. 6th

Pleasant weather. Light breeze from S.W. Wind part
Saw part the same so ends.
