Calm weather land still in sight. Rusted Albatrosses and Mair boat. Wind and Lat part calm and light air so ends.

Oct. 26th

Fine weather since light from S.E. Land still in sight. Wind and Lat part fresh breeze and rain.

Oct. 27th

Fresh breeze from S.W. on sail in sight. Wind and Lat part weather do so ends.

Mon. Oct. 28th

Moderate weather and fine breeze from the S.E. Wind and Lat part do so ends.

Thurs. Oct. 29th

Moderate weather and light wind from the Southward. Wind part same. Lat part wind from the Southward steering S.E. so ends.

Wed. Oct. 30th

Fine weather and moderate breeze from Southward steering S.E. saw three Finbacks. Wind part steady. S. wind good breeze from North. Land in sight.

Thurs. Oct. 31st

Fine weather good breeze from S.W. steering S.W. Wind part short sail and Captn to the rear on starboard tack. Lat part sailing and unsettled weather. Saw Finbacks so ends.

Friday, Oct. 1st

Cloudy weather and light breeze from S.W. ship under short sail on port tack saw Finbacks & Porpoises. Wind and Lat part good breeze.

Sat. Oct. 2nd

Weather thick and rainy since from S.W. good breeze. Wind part same. Lat part blowing a strong breeze squally ship under close reefed main & fore so ends.

Sun. Nov. 3rd

Wind still from S.W. strong breeze ship by the wind on western tack under double reefed topsails at 3 P.M. were ship at Miami's steering S.E. Wind part same. Lat part made all sail. Fine weather.

Mon. Nov. 4th

Our weather all day set good breeze from S.W. steering S.W. Wind and Lat part same.

Tues. Nov. 5th

Fine weather since S.W. steering S.W. Wind part light air. Land in sight. Lat part lying off and on Cape.

Wednes. Nov. 6th

Capt went on shore very pleasant weather. Capt sick with cancer on his face.

Fri. Nov. 15th

Took our departure from Norfolk Island. Ship in command of Mr. Murray. Capt. Allen on shore command. Surgeon. Governor. Mr. S.B. 1650 and Mr. Connelly. Sydney. 400 have been off and on here during the past week. The surgeon yesterday returned from Auckland bringing the mail. Have received liberty while here.

Sat. Nov. 16th

Fine weather. Island bearing 8 distant 8 miles. Wind part calm. Lat part light breeze.

Sun. Nov. 17th

Fine weather and light breeze from E.S. ship on port tack. Wind and Lat part the same.

Mon. Nov. 18th

Corn with fine breeze from S.W. saw Bramblers. Wind part light breeze. Lat part the same.

Tues. Nov. 19th

Corn with fine weather and good breeze from Eastward. Saw Bramblers. Wind part fine. Lat part making towards so ends.

Wed. Nov. 20th

Weather fine good breeze from S.W. saw a Finback. Employed measuring fucina finchbone. Wind part pleasant. Lat part strong breeze from the S.W.

Thurs. Nov. 21st

Strong breeze from the S.W. Wind and Lat part the same.

Fri. Nov. 22nd

Strong breeze from Eastward and very rough. Wind and Lat part do.

Sat. Nov. 23rd

Blowing a young gale from the Eastward. Wind and Lat part do. so ends.

Sun. Nov. 24th

Weather better good breeze from Eastward. Saw two sails. Wind part calm. Lat part light air. Three sails. also Norfolk Island. Island in sight.
