 employed in making Spungum  
 Middle part Winds change to S.W. Ship by the  
 Wind Standing to North. got 6 crows a piece  
 from Mate latter part the same  
 all is well on Board nothing in sight  
 thus ends the day

Thursday June - - - 26<sup>th</sup>  
 these 24 hours come in with fresh gales  
 from N.W. Ship by the wind one sail  
 in sight making small Boat sail  
 for himself Middle part Winds the same  
 Ship flying too under two Close reefed  
 top sails latter part Winds changed to  
 N.W. with lulls and rain squalls  
 all is well on Board so far so good  
 thus ends the day

Friday June - - - 27<sup>th</sup>  
 this day begins with a fresh breeze  
 from N.W. Ship by the wind to N.E.  
 nothing in sight every thing quiet  
 on Board Middle part Winds the  
 same shook one reef out of main top sail  
 one sail in sight latter part Winds  
 the same set up ~~two~~ one side cross  
 with new strap one sail in sight  
 no Whales yet  
 thus ends the day

Saturday June - - - 28<sup>th</sup>  
 this day begins with a fresh breeze  
 from N.W. Ship by the wind to North  
 3<sup>rd</sup> Mate making long sail for Boat  
 Middle part Winds the same nothing in sight  
 set main top sail and bent Mignon Stang sail  
 latter part the same one sail in  
 sight Boat Bound to Westward  
 all hands employed in washing Decks  
 and paint work all is well on Board  
 thus ends the day

## Atlantic Ocean on Barque Sea Ranges

Sunday June - - - 29<sup>th</sup>  
 these 24 hours begin with a fresh breeze  
 from N.W. Ship by the wind standing  
 to North very foggy and rainy  
 Middle part change of Wind to S.W.  
 with rain and thick weather  
 latter part Wind change to N.W.  
 Ship by the wind see one sail  
 and a small white water  
 all is well on Board  
 thus ends the day

Monday June - - - 30<sup>th</sup>  
 these 24 hours begin with a fresh  
 breeze from N.W. Ship by the wind fresh  
 fore top sail Middle part Winds the same  
 fore top sail to South tossed fore top sail  
 Mate making as much noise as all hands  
 latter part Winds the same Ship by the  
 Wind all hands employed in washing Decks  
 finish sewing Boat sail for now  
 one Boatswain in sight  
 all is well on Board  
 so far so good thus ends the day

Tuesday July - - - 1<sup>st</sup>  
 this day begins with light air  
 from N.W. Ship by the wind  
 two sails in sight black Smith employed  
 in making dogs for the top sail masts  
 Middle part Winds from West. at work  
 on my Boat sail making it looser  
 latter part fresh breeze Ship by the  
 Wind did not wash decks to night  
 put up Masthead board to stand  
 on thick fog men aloft  
 all is well on board

Wednesday July - - - 2<sup>nd</sup>  
 this day begins with a moderate  
 breeze from N.W. Ship by the Wind  
 standing to S.W. Middle part Winds  
 the same saw some gannets and  
 lowered for sperm Whales was a big haul  
 but exercised Boats crows latter part Winds  
 the same very light with thick fog  
 some gimbals and porpoise in sight  
 nothing interesting thus ends the day
