

## On Board the Barque

Saturday July 12th  
 these 24 hours come in with  
 a moderate breeze from S.W.  
 and clearing weather one sail  
 in sight Middle part Winds the  
 same Ship by the wind  
 the watch employed in cleaning  
 iron work latter part the same  
 put Boat sail on yard for try  
 all is well on Board so ends the  
 day.

Sunday July 13th  
 this day comes in with a calm  
 very pleasant Sabbath  
 capt gives out bibles and papers  
 Middle part a very light air  
 from S.W. saw a Whaling Schooner  
 latter part the same very thing  
 very quite all is well on Board  
 so ends the day.

Monday July 14th  
 this day comes in with a light  
 air from S.W. the watch employed  
 in speaking out Water Beef and pork  
 Middle part Wind the same  
 sighted Whaling Schooner at work  
 finishing my Boat sail  
 latter part Wind the same  
 and very light saw rigging for Boat  
 sail run down to Whaling Schooner  
 union and gunned so ends the day.

Tuesday July 15th  
 these 24 hours come in with light  
 air from W. Ship by the wind  
 a faller calm got Boats ready  
 for sperm Whales but proved to be  
 a Spar Middle part Winds the  
 same took in Spear on deck  
 plenty of fish latter part the same  
 several sails in sight employed  
 in catching fish all is well on board  
 so ends the day.

## Sea Ranger of New Bedford 1879

Wednesday July 16th  
 these 24 hours begin with a light  
 breeze from W. Ship by the wind  
 called all hands to get Boats  
 ready for sperm Whales but  
 and lowered two Boats but  
 with out success Middle part  
 Winds the same Whaling  
 Schooner in sight latter part  
 the same several sails in sight  
 plenty of porpoises and grampus  
 in sight so ends the day.

Thursday July 17th  
 these 24 hours come in with  
 a fresh breeze from S.W. Ship by the  
 wind saw a small white water  
 Middle part Wind the same saw very  
 light getting ready to put up Spring stay  
 to Mizzen latter part Winds the same  
 one large Steamer in sight all is well  
 on Board so ends the day.

Friday July 18th  
 this day begins with a gentle breeze  
 from S.W. put in Spender on Mizzen  
 top Mast rising Middle part nearly  
 a calm the watch employed in  
 mending and splitting up Spear  
 latter part Winds the same but very  
 light saw some grampus  
 all goes well on Board so far so ends  
 the day.

Saturday July 19th  
 these 24 hours come in with a gentle  
 breeze from S.E. Ship by the wind  
 the watch employed in breaking out  
 water down lower hole and hanning and  
 splitting up Spear of Spanish Ceader  
 Middle part Winds the same Steaming  
 N.W. clothing including latter part  
 Winds the same and Steaming the same  
 sent down Mering Spencer gaff  
 and put up stay for Spender  
 so ends the day.
