Monday July 21st  
this day began with a gentle  
breeze from SSW Ship Steaming North  
the watch employed in Shattering  
Blocks and working in rigging  
Cooper put in place of new Sheathing  
in the Mast Middle part Winds the  
same and Ship Steaming the same  
latter part Wind from ESE Ship came  
to mind lowered a Boat and picked  
up Bassal. Nothing including for the  
day So ends the

Tuesday July 22nd  
these 24 hours came in with  
a gentle breeze from ESE Ship Steaming  
NW the watch employed in setting  
up the fore lower rigging sails in sight  
Middle part Winds the same and  
Ship Steaming the same Cooper and  
Carpenter employed in making new  
bench latter part Winds the same  
saw some gammas and several  
sails one got called a Whaling Bark  
So ends the day

Wednesday July 23rd  
these 24 hours came in with a gentle  
breeze from ESE Ship Steaming to North  
and West Signalized Merchant Bark  
and gained her. Capt. traded, later on  
the ship Middle part Winds the same  
Ship Steaming the same the watch employed  
in setting up rigging latter part the  
same all of Nelson on board the  
for logwood So ends the day

## Atlantic Ocean 1879

Thursday July 24th  
these 24 hours came in with a fine breeze  
from ESE Ship by the Wind on Starboard  
back two bands in sight the watch  
employed in making Suet broke out after  
dinner got out Butter Vinegar and Meal  
Middle part Winds the same Ship by the  
Wind the watch employed in sawing up  
Spanish Cedar log and latter part  
Winds the same at half past 4 o'clock  
lacked Ship. Raised a large White Water  
to leeward but saw it no more  
So ends the day

Friday July 25th  
these 24 hours came with a gentle breeze  
from ESE Ship by the Wind the  
watch employed in Breaking out Water  
and and flour found Casks of Beef and pork  
in the ground near next to Cabin Box  
Middle part Winds the same  
nothing in sight the watch employed in  
painting iron work red latter part  
Winds the same Nothing including  
for the day So ends the

Saturday July 26th  
these 24 hours came with a light  
breeze from NW Ship Steaming East  
only sail in sight the watch  
employed in Breaking out Beef and  
pork Middle part a Calm one sail  
in sight latter part a gentle  
breeze from NW Ship Steaming East  
saw some gammas in sight Nothing  
including for the day So ends

Sunday July 27th  
these 24 hours came in with a moderate  
breeze from NW Ship Steaming East  
Nothing visible Middle part  
adjusted quadrant but got no sight  
some White Water in sight  
latter part Winds the same  
and Steaming the same  
nothing including for the day  
So ends
