Tuesday July - 29th
 This day begins with a gentle breeze from S. by E. Ship steering S.E. the Watch employed in redistributing Main top Sail Halyard Block and painting Green work Middle part Winds the same and steering the same got two new Iron Straps latter part Winds very light from W. by N. steering the same one Steamer in sight Nothing including for the day So ends

Wednesday July - 30th
 These 24 hours come in with a fresh breeze from N. by W. Ship by the Wind on Starboard tack the Watch employed in Blacksmithing and making Spanline for Main Middle part Winds the same tacked Ship and hove to N. by E. saw some small Breeches and one Sail latter part Winds the same shortened Sail saw one large piece of Squidie Nothing included So ends the day

Thursday July - 31st
 This day begins with a strong breeze from W. by N. Ship by the Wind all in Well on board the Watch employed in painting Machine. Bell Bone and red Middle part Winds the same tacked Ship Cooper making Crains for Bug light ones the S. by E. Mincing Machine in sight So ends the day

 These 24 hours come in with a light breeze from N. by E. Ship by the Wind saw Mincing Machine Union to land the Watch employed in Breaking out Water from ground tier Middle part Winds the same But very light Made one iron pole Cooper making out Rigger for Main to Gaber Back Star latter part Winds the same employed in setting up Dip gages and making Net Work for fire Ship Nothing in sight

Saturday August - 2nd
 These 24 hours come in with a light breeze from S. by W. Ship by the Wind Nothing in sight the Watch employed in setting up fore top Mast Back Stays Middle part Winds the same Ship steering off Mincing Machine in sight latter part Winds the same saw some Sprouts and Ship come to Wind

Sunday August - 3rd
 This day begins with a moderate breeze from S. by E. Ship by the Wind very clearing weather Middle part Winds the same saw some small Breeches and ran off for three passed to be grampuses Cooper very sick with pains in Stomach latter part Winds the same Ship come to Wind and took in hail No Whistling aloud So ends the day

Monday - August 4th
 These 24 hours begin with a calm and light air from S. by E. employed in working in rigging and painting Iron Work also cleaning Caps and painting it. Some grampuses in sight and two Sails Middle part a light breeze from S. by E. Ship steering E. by South Cooper saw better latter part Winds the same and steering the same times very dull for the 36th Nothing included
