Tuesday August 15th
one
Bowl stur there 24 hours come with addition
of duty and light from S.W.
Saw and lowered for what we call
Sperm Whales but proved to be
a log and some grampus Middle
part light and from the same
quarter Boats come on Board
One Boat steamer off duty Sick
latter part Winds the same
Ship by the wind So ends

Wednesday August 16th 6th
this day begins with a gentle
breeze from S.W. Ship by the wind
the watch employed in cleaning
Killed and fitting Blocks for
Shank's gun. Middle part Wind S
the same Hacked Ship for some Breeds
Making Schooner in sight
latter part Winds the same Ship by
the wind on port tack Saw a
large Spar to leeward Nothing included
for the day So ends

Thursday August 17th 7th
this day begins with a strong
breeze from W.S.W. Ship steering
North the watch employed in breaking
out the main hatch for one cask of
Beef and Water Middle part Winds
the same with squalls of rain
Ship steering the same Storing
Back main Hatch very equally and
rainy latter part Winds the same
Ship steering the same and
Ship came to wind Saw small
white water So ends the day

Friday August 18th 8th
this day begins with a fresh
breeze from West Ship by the wind
the watch employed in making
Broom stuff Cooper making Bed for
Cook and Carpenter Making Cheats for
Copper rollers Middle part Winds the
same with some squalls
latter part Winds the same
Nothing included for the day

Ocean for Sperm Whales 17th

Saturday August 9th
this day begins with a fresh
breeze from W. Ship by the wind
Cooper tore down old Rye Bench
Middle part Winds the same
Ship standing to North
all is well on Board nothing
in sight latter part Winds
the same a very dull day So ends

Sunday August 10th
these 24 hours come in with a fresh
breeze from W. Ship by the wind
everything very quiet on board
Middle part Winds from the same
quarter but moderate S.W. and
Main top galant Sail
latter part Winds the same but light
all is well on Board No sails in
sight So ends the day

Monday August 11th
these 24 hours come in with a
moderate breeze from W. Ship steering
by the wind to North all hands
employed in sending down fore
and main top sails for repairs
and shifted them Middle part
Winds the same but very light
one sail in sight and some
grampus latter part Winds the
same weather grows cooler
shortened sail all is well on
Board So ends the day

Tuesday August 12th
these 24 hours come with a moderate
breeze from W. Ship by the wind
to North Middle part Winds the
same and Ship steering the same
Work getting scarce Nothing in
sight latter part Winds the same
and Ship steering one sail in
sight Make bent storm sail
for Boat all is well on Board
So ends the day
