Sunday Sept 14th
These 24 Hours came in with a fine breeze from NNE Ship laying off. Port prior capt went on shore. Middle part Winds the same Capt came on Board Ship steering off to Westward latter part Winds the same two sails in sight run down and spoke the platina and Schooner Clara Le Sparks and gained So ends the day

Monday Sept 15th
These 24 Hours came in with a light breeze from ENE Ship steering to Westward for pic very clearing West Middle part Winds the same but very light little wind on shore on tobacco business but with out success latter part Winds changed to S.W. Ship steering by the wind bound to payal. So ends the day

Tuesday Sept 16th
These 24 Hours came in with a moderate breeze from North Ship laying off and on at payal getting ready to send oil ashore Middle part Winds the same with some squalls off rain several Ships laying off and on landing oil latter part Winds changed to West finish getting out oil. So ends the day

Wednesday Sept 17th
These 24 Hours came in with a breeze from West Ship steering off and on sending off oil Middle part Winds the same Ship laying off and on oil all ashore latter part Winds the same but light second mate came on Board So ends the day

These 24 Hours came in with fresh breezes from NNE Ship by the wind under double reef top sails the watch employed in breaking out flour and water Middle part Winds the same and Ship by the wind broke out Coffee latter part Winds the same and Ship steering the same payal and pic in sight So ends the day

Saturday Sept 20th
These 24 Hours came in with a fresh breeze from North Ship by the wind payal and pic in sight the watch employed in general work about decks Middle part Winds the same and Ship by the wind several sails in sight cooper setting up Shooks latter part Winds the same and Ship by the wind one Boat Steerer off duty Peter So ends the day

Sunday Sept 21st
These 24 Hours came in with a light breeze from ENE Ship by the wind payal pic George grace oes in sight Middle part Winds the same Ship beating to windward 2 sails in sight latter part Winds change to SE Ship steering by the wind 3 sails in sight called Water's Peter off duty yet So far so good
