

On Board Bark Sea Ranges

Thursday, Oct 16th 1877
 These 24 Tugs come in with a moderate
 breeze from SE Ship laying off
 and on taking fruit and
 vegetables. Middle part the same
 and Ship laying off and on
 latter part the same Capt came
 on Board with 8 green hands
 left the Island steering S and W
 So ends the day

Friday, Oct 17th

This day come in with
 light air from S and SE Ship
 steering S and W the watch
 put in employed in working down
 to the Main Hatch and the
 Second Hatch the same with
 North light squalls off rain still
 at work down the Main Hatch
 at latter part Wind's the
 same and steering S and W
 still at work finish of stowing
 back the Main Hatch one sail
 So ends the day

Saturday, Oct 18th
 This day come in with a moderate
 breeze from S and W with squalls of
 rain and whirl winds Middle part
 Winds the same but very light
 2 Sails in sight one Whaler
 offing going on to day
 latter part the calm 2 Sails in
 sight So ends the day

Sunday, Oct 19th
 This day come in with a calm
 Several Sails in sight one is
 a Whaler Middle part light airs
 from East Ship steering SE Saw
 a large shoal of Black fish
 change of wind with squalls of
 rain latter part Winds from
 S Ship steering S and W
 So ends the day

Monday, Oct 20th 1877
 These 24 Tugs come in with a light
 breeze from S Ship by the Wind
 Several Sails in sight one a Whaler
 Broke the Watch employed in fixing
 up the Ship Sheets Middle part Winds
 the same and Ship steering by the
 Wind Signalized an English Ship
 latter part Winds the same with
 some squalls of rain Nothing off in the

Tuesday, Oct 21st
 This day come in with a breeze from
 from SE Ship steering by the Wind
 Several Sails in sight and offhales
 the Watch employed in Strapping Blocks
 for Rigger Middle part Winds varied
 to SWacked Ship Cooper Making
 Boat Mast for Mate latter part
 Winds the same with some squalls
 of rain So ends the day

Wednesday, Oct 22nd
 This day come in with a moderate
 breeze from SE Ship steering by the
 Wind the Watch employed in
 making Deck and general Work about
 Making Deck Middle part Winds the same
 and Ship steering the same
 Several Sails in sight and
 one a Whaler Making small
 Stowage Sail for my Boat latter part
 Boat Winds the same and steering the same
 Caught one porpoise So ends today

Thursday, Oct 23rd
 This day come in with a moderate
 breeze from SE Ship steering by
 the Wind to South the Watch employed
 in Making Deck the fly of the yard
 parted 8 times Middle part Winds
 varied 2 or 3 points up and off from
 E steering by the Wind some very
 heavy squalls of Wind and rain
 latter part Winds the same and
 Ship steering the same one
 Sail in sight So ends the day
 at the swimming over
