Sunday June 6th

These 24 Hours come in with a light trade wind and partly cloudy weather. Ship steering close haul on the wind on Eastern tack with all sail and the Bark Alice knows to windward. Middle part winds more fresh one pin back in sight and same pursued. Latter part the same Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Monday June 7th

These 24 Hours come in with a light trade wind cloudy and smoky weather. Ship steering to Eastward. One sail in sight to leeward. The watch employed at setting up the foremast over Middle part the same employed at setting up the foremast. Latter part the same come to wind on port tack under short sail one pin back in sight Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Tuesday June 8th

These 24 Hours come in with moderate trades and clear weather. Ship steering to Eastward. The watch employed at setting up the foremast. Middle part the same 2 pin backs and a shoal of black fish in sight. Latter part the same Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Wednesday June 9th

These 24 Hours come in with moderate trade wind and very cloudy weather. Ship steering N.E. The watch doing in the rigging. Middle part winds more fresh on pin back in sight. Latter part the same ship come to wind on port tack to Westward. Close haul Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Thursday June 10th

These 24 Hours come in with moderate trades wind and cloudy weather. Ship steering close haul on the port tack to watch employed at setting up the foremast. Middle part the same saw one pin back. Latter part the same same pursued. Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Friday June 11th

These 24 Hours come in with moderate trade winds and cloudy weather. Ship steering close haul. The watch employed at setting up the foremast. Middle part the same one sail in sight. Latter part the same lowered for a shoal of black fish Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Saturday June 12th

These 24 Hours come in with moderate trades and cloudy weather. Ship steering close haul on the port tack with all sail in sight. Middle part the watch employed at mining black fish. Latter part the same some pin backs in sight. Bark Alice knows to windward Howard off duty. So ends the day.

These 24 Hours come in with moderate trades and pleasant but cloudy weather. Ship steering to East. The Bark Alice knows in sight to windward. Middle part the same one pin back in sight. Latter part the same gained. The Bark Alice knows shortened sail. So ends Howard off duty.

Monday June 13th

These 24 hours come in with a light trade wind and very cloudy weather. Ship steering N.E. Some pin backs in sight. The watch employed at setting up the foremast. Middle part the same black something going on. Latter part the same took in sail and came to wind on port tack to Westward. Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Tuesday June 14th

These 24 Hours come in with moderate trades and very clear weather. Ship steering N.E. The watch employed at setting up the foremast. Middle part the same black something going on. Latter part the same saw some pin backs. Took in all sail. Ship steering N.E. Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Wednesday June 15th

These 24 Hours come in with strong trades and very clear weather. Ship steering N.E. The watch employed at setting up the foremast. Middle part the same employed at boiling out blackfish blubber. Latter part the same Howard off duty. So ends the day.

Thursday June 16th

These 24 Hours come in with strong trade winds and very clear weather. Ship steering N.E. under hole main top sail and double reefed fore and fore sail. The watch employed at working in the rigging and clearing decks. Middle part the same saw some pin backs to leeward. Latter part the same ship came to wind on Eastern tack. Howard off duty. So ends the day.
