Sunday Jan 23rd
Strong breeze from West

Monday Jan 24th
Strong breeze from West

Tuesday Jan 25th
Strong breeze from West
Ship steering East S.E.

Wednesday Jan 26th
Strong breezes from SW

Thursday Jan 27th
Very fine winds from NW.
Ship steering S.E. at night lost
reefed the top sails

Friday Jan 28th
Moderate breeze
Ship steering E.S.E. under all sail
at night came down under a close reefed
Main top sail and fore top sail furled
Saturday Jan 29th
Wind from the off with thick
foggy weather under short sail
only Eastern tack

Sunday Jan 30th
Strong breeze from West
Ship steering E.S.E. under a single
reefed fore top sail and Main
sailant sail

Monday Jan 31st
Very light weather all sail out
Ship steering North
