Tuesday June 21st

This day comes in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack ship Olga Adams to leeward latter part gammed so ends

Wednesday June 22nd

This day comes in with a light trade wind ship steering by the wind to Eastward the watch jolting about decks one deer in sight Mistletoe part backed ship some grampuses in sight latter part wore ship again again within sail down

Thursday June 23rd

This day comes in with a moderate breeze ship steering by the wind to Westward saw some fin backs and one seal the watch engaged at enlarging main stay sail so ends

Friday June 24th

This day comes in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind to Eastward middle part saw some fin backs and porpoises the watch engaged at enlarging main top Mast stay sail latter part caught two porpoises so ends

Saturday June 25th

There 24 hours come in with a moderate trade wind and very cloudy ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack raised a barometer on weather quarter backed ship the watch employed at breaking out water latter part backed ship again ship Olga Adams in sight to leeward so ends the day

Sunday June 26th

This day comes in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack plenty of fin backs in sight Mistletoe part one seal in sight to leeward wore ship so ends

There 24 hours come in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack ship Olga Adams to leeward latter part gammed so ends

Tuesday June 28th

This day comes in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack the watch employed at breaking out fore peak and restoring back saw some fin backs and gammed so ends

Wednesday June 29th

This day comes in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind to Eastward motion in sight to day so ends

Thursday June 30th

This day comes in with a fresh trade wind ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack some fin backs in sight the watch jolting about decks one deer off duty with sore hand so ends

Friday July 1st

This day comes in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack some fin backs in sight wore ship the watch jolting about decks so ends

Saturday July 2nd

This day comes in with a moderate trade wind ship steering by the wind on Eastern tack some fin backs in sight the watch jolting about decks so ends

Sunday July 3rd

This day comes in with a light trade wind ship steering N.W. some fin backs in sight Mr. Gomes off duty with tooth ache and Serephene off duty with needle in his hand very bad off. Steerman takes the watch so ends

Monday July 4th

This day comes in with a calm and light air from all quarters ship steering East N.E. saw large log covered olma Boat and caught a good many fish also catching them from Mistletoe saw a fin backs bottom and wore ship so ends still off duty and Serephene with sore hand so ends the 4th of July
