 This day comes in with a light trade
 wind ship steering by the wind on
 Eastern tack the watch fobing about
 decks one sail in sight also one fin back
 and some porpoises. Still one man off duty

Friday July 8th
 This day comes in with a moderate
 breeze wind ship steering Eastward
 by the wind ship Eliza Adams in sight
 the watch fobing about decks
 latter part garmaned Eliza. San
 back to windward. So ends

Saturday July 9th
 This day comes in with a light trade wind
 ship steering by the same on Western tack
 the watch fobing about decks
 ship Eliza Adams in sight one man off duty
 So ends

Sunday July 10th
 This day comes in with a light trade
 wind ship steering by the same on
 Western tack ship Eliza Adams
 in sight Middle part tacked ship
 one man off duty. So ends

Monday July 11th
 This day comes in with a light trade
 wind ship steering by the same on
 Eastern tack ship Eliza Adams in
 sight to leeward some fin backs in
 sight one man off duty. So ends

Wednesday July 13th
 This day comes in with a light trade
 wind ship steering by the same on Eastern
 tack under all sail plenty of fin backs
 and porpoises in sight the watch breaking
 out water and fobing about decks
 latter part tacked ship and took in sail
 heading to the South Seraphene still off duty
 So ends

Thursday July 14th
 This day comes in with a light trade wind
 ship steering by the wind on Western
 tack the watch engaged at washing
 and drying of the sails latter part Capt and
 mate lowered for black fish but without
 success on fin back in sight still one
 man off duty. So ends

Friday July 15th
 This day comes in with a light trade wind
 ship steering by the same on Western tack
 under all sail the watch fobing about decks
 one fin back in sight one man still off duty
 So ends

Saturday July 16th
 This day comes in with a light trade wind
 ship steering by the same under all sail
 the watch washing ship one sulphur
 bottom and some speck fish in sight lowered
 fore boat for the latter part without
 success Seraphene off duty latter part
 back to leeward. So ends

Sunday July 17th
 This day comes in with a light trade
 wind ship steering by the same under
 all sail on Western tack under all sail
 nothing but some grampuses in sight
 one man off duty. So ends
