Nov. 6th. - Fine. Cruising in Bouka Bay. Light breeze. Refitted gallant yard and sent it up at 11 o'clock. Afternoon set up starboard mizzen rigging & martingale. Starb. watch all day on deck. Sunset kept off E. by S. bound to New Zealand.

Nov. 7th. - Cloudy. Wind light S. & W. Course E. by S. Land off weather gunster. Mended fore topsail on the yard. At work on rigging fore and aft. Set up jib guys larb side. Lat. 5.37 S, long. 155.42 E.

Nov. 8th. - Fine. Wind S. E. light. Course E. by S. Took foot ropes off main topsail yard and refitted them. Set up fore stay. 4 P.M. Land off lee beam.

Sunset course E. Lat. 5.15 S, long. 156.43 E.

Nov. 9th. - Tacked at 4 A.M. heading S. E. Sunrise fine; wind light E. by S. Down fore topgallant sail to mend. Took foot ropes off main yard to refit. Went down fore topgallant yard to

fit the rigging. 4 P.M. seized foot ropes on main yard. Crossed fore topgallant yard.

Sunset wind E. by S. Lat. 5.21 S, long. 157.37 E.

Nov. 10th. - Cloudy. Wind E. Close-hauled.

Mending fore topgallant sail. 10 A.M. rain. 4 P.M. commenced to wet hold but knocked off soon after, the hose leaking badly. Mended hose. Lat. 5.34 S, long. 158.01 E.

Nov. 11th. - Sunday. Fine. Wind N. E. Course E. by S. 4 P.M. made another unsuccessful attempt to wet the oil in the hold; the hose leaked worse than before. Rain part of the night. Lat. 5.47 S, long. 158.34 E.

Nov. 12th. - Fine. Light airs from E. & S. Course E. by S. Mending fore topgallant sail. Bent it after dinner. Lat. 6.11 S, long. 159.06 E.

Nov. 13th. - Wind N. E. Course E. by S. Fine weather. Broke out four casks water from starb. side of main hatch. Broke out cask molasses & barrel of beef. No other.

Nov. 14th. - Cloudy. Wind S. & E. Course E. by S. Taking scrub boards. Wet hold. No other.

Nov. 15th. - Fine. Wind S. E. Course E. Sunset.
