

Last sail Rugged 10 at M. made all sail. Lat. 43.36 S. Long. 146.52 W.

Mar. 13. - Fresh breeze N.W. Course E. 1/2 S. All sail out. 10 at M. called all hands, clewed up & clewed down topsails, courses, topgallant sails, hauled down topmast studding sails jibs, spanker & gaff topsail, to repair bobstays injured in the late gale. Noon made all sail. Sunset wind N.W. Lat. 43.36 S, Long. 146.52 W.

Mar. 14. - Cloudy. Strong breeze N.W. Lat. 44.55 S, Long. 146.32 W.

Mar. 15. - Cloudy. Strong breeze N.W. 2 P.M. furled topgallant sails. 6 P.M. reefed topsails. Furlled jibs at 8 P.M. Furlled fore topsail and mainsail in the middle watch. Lat. 46.30 S, Long. 136.12 W.

Mar. 16. - Moderated. Wind N.W. Set close reefed fore topsail, and main topgallant sail over single reefed topsails. Course E. by S. Noon, calm. 2 P.M. light breeze N. Lat. Long.

Mar. 17. - Cloudy. Biting. Strong breeze N. Course E. 1/2 S. Lat. Long.

Mar. 18. - Cloudy & rainy. Strong breeze N. Course E. 1/2 S. Lat. Long.

Mar. 19. - Cloudy & foggy. Moderated. Wind N.W. N.

Course E. Fore topmast studding sail out. Very heavy fog with rain through the night. Lat. Long.

Mar. 20. - Cloudy. Light breeze N.W. Sunset, wind N.W. 11 P.M. blowing a gale from the S. and E. Hove to under a close reefed main topsail. Lat. Long.

Mar. 21. - Blowing a gale. Rain. Moderated after dinner. Made sail at sunset, wind S. Lat. Long.

Mar. 22. - Strong breeze S. Course E. Reefed topsails & courses, jib & spanker out. Lat. Long.

Mar. 23. - Fresh breeze W. Everything out. Lat. 51.37 S, Long. 110.17 W.

Mar. 24. - Cloudy. Light breeze W. S. W. All sail out. Lat. 52.36 S, Long. 105.55 W.

Mar. 25. - Fine. Light breeze W. Course E. Lat. 53.08 S, Long. 103.07 W.

Mar. 26. - Fine. Light breeze W. Course E. 1/2 S. At 9 o'clock this evening the man on the lookout cried out Land! had three points off the lee bow. All hands pumped up from below fore and aft, as we were certain that we were nearly 1000 miles from any known land. We hauled
