This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E. heading
S.W. with all sail set. Middle and
Latter part heading S.W. by S. at Lat 028.

Friday Dec 5th Lon 3128 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E. by S heading
S.W. by S. with all sail set. Middle
and Latter part heading S.W. with
part of the light sail set to ends Lat 239 S

Saturday Dec 6th Lon 3211 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E. heading S.W.
with part of the light sails set. Middle
part at nine Lacked to S.E. at three
to S.W. Latter part at eight saw the
Island of Fernando Polonha, at Twelve
the Island bearing 6 Ten miles dist
to ends. Lat 351 S

Sunday Dec 7th Lon 3221 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E. heading S.W.
with all sail set at one Lacked to
S.E. saw spouts and breeches. Think
they were sperm whales going to
windward quick at three Lacked
to S.W. the Island bearing 6 S.E. at
sun down, fifteen miles distance
Middle and Latter part heading
S.W. by S. to ends. Lat 618 S

Monday Dec 8th

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E. heading S.W.
with part of the light sails set. Middle
part the same Latter part with the
light sails furled to ends Lat 840 S

Tuesday Dec 9th Lon 3336 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E. heading
S.W. with the light sails furled.
Middle part the same Latter part
with part of the light sails set
to ends this day Lat 1108 S

Wednesday Dec 10th Lon 3403 W

This day comes in with pleasant
weather and light wind from S.E.
heading S.W. with part of the light
sails set. Middle and Latter part
heading S.W. to ends Lat 1331 S

Thursday Dec 11th Lon 3410 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E. heading S.
with part of the light sails set.
Middle part with reef top sails
Latter part the light sails furled
heading S.W. to ends. Lat 1605 S

Friday Dec 12th Lon 3427 W

This day comes in with equally weather
and strong wind from S.E. heading S.
with the light sails furled. Middle
part with reef top sails Latter part
with part of the light sails set steering
S.W. to ends Lat 1814 S
