Thursday Feb 5th

This day comes in with pleasant weather and calm cut in the body of the whale the head laying along side Middle part strong wind from N. Latter part at eight cut away from the head all hands employed boiling and clearing the deck so ends

Lat 38.12 S

Friday Feb 6th Lon 48.25 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N. heading S. S. W under short sail boiling Middle part the same Latter part steering N. S. W under short sail wind so ends 38.25 S

Saturday Feb 7th Lon 48.21 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E steering N. S. W under short sail at two finished boiling at three saw a large sperm whale. at six lowered the boats the Larboard boat struck and lost the line Middle part at eleven blowing a light gale Latter part blowing a gale heading S with close reef main top sail set, raining all hands employed striking the oil down in the fore hold so ends

Sunday Feb 8th

This day comes in with thick and rainy weather blowing a gale from E heading S with the lee clew of main top sail set and fore top mast stay set Middle and Latter part the same so ends Lat 39.07 S Lon 48.16 W

Monday Feb 9th

This day comes in with rain and thick weather blowing a gale from E heading S with fore top mast stay sail and the lee clew of the main top sail set. at five set the main stay sail at six a sea boarded and stowed the waste boat. a very heavy sea on. Middle part moderating Latter part calm so ends.

Lat 38.45 S

Tuesday Feb 10th Lon 47.10 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and calm with a very heavy swell. Middle part the same Latter part at ten a light breeze from S. S. E heading S. W with all sail set. at half past eleven saw sperm whales so ends 38.44 S

Wednesday Feb 11th 47.18 W

This day comes in with thick foggy weather and light wind from S. S. E steering E westward in chase of the whales. at three lowered the boats at four the boats came to the ship at five lowered again at sun down came on board and shortened sail Middle and Latter part steering S. W under short sail so ends Lat 39.22 S

Thursday Feb 12th 48.27 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from N. E steering S. W under short sail all hands employed stowing oil at one spoke the ship Drap Middle part wind N. S. W heading S. Latter part wind S. S. W heading S. E so ends Lat 40.08 S Lon 48.38 W
