Thursday April 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from S.E. steering S.W. with all sail set. Middle part steering S.W. under reef. Latter part steering S.W. with all sail set so ends. Lat 0.15 S

Friday April 24<sup>th</sup> Lon 123.23 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from S.E. steering S.W. with all sail set. Middle part with the light sail furled steering S.W. Latter part with all sail set steering S.W. at half past nine saw sperm whales at twelve lowered the boats so ends. No Obs.

Saturday April 25<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E. steering different courses in chase of the whales the Starboard boat struck and captured the Starboard boat struck and captured at half past five took the whales along side and commenced cutting at dark lashed the head Middle part with men short sail Latter part at day light commenced cutting again at ten finished cutting and commenced hauling so ends. Lat 0.06 S

Sunday April 26<sup>th</sup> Lon 123.34 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from S.E. heading S.W. with the light sails furled boiling and clearing the deck. Middle part heading S.W. Latter part at ten were ship so ends. Lat 0.43 S

Monday April 27<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E heading S.W. with the light sails furled boiling Middle part the same Latter part with part of the light sails set so ends. Lat 0.53 S

Tuesday April 28<sup>th</sup> Lon 122.54 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E heading S.W. with all sail set finished boiling at two a strong current setting S.E. Middle part heading S. Latter part heading S.W. at eleven saw sperm whales so ends Lat 0.14 S

Wednesday April 29<sup>th</sup> Lon 122.05 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from S.E. steering S.W. in chase of whales at one lowered the boats the Starboard boat struck and captured Middle part at one took the whale along side Middle part laying by the whale with all sail clewed up and down the head yards aback. Latter part at six commenced cutting at eight finished cutting and made all sail heading S so ends. Lat 0.09 S

Thursday April 30<sup>th</sup> Lon 122.57 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from S.E. heading S. with all sail set at four began to boil. Middle part boiling heading S. with the light sails furled Latter part with all sail set so ends. Lat 1.05 S
