Monday Sept 21<sup>st</sup>

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.E. heading N.W. with all sail set at five saw the Island of New Samtucket and one sail Middle part heading S.E. Latter part steering S. so Ends Lat 055° S

Tuesday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> Lon 176.19 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E.N.E. steering S. with all sail set. Middle part working to windward Latter part steering N.W. so Ends Lat 1° 58' S

Wednesday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup> Lon 176.57 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E steering N.W. with all sail set. Middle part working to windward Latter part steering N.W. so Ends Lat 029° S

Thursday Sept 24<sup>th</sup> Lon 177.38 W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.E. steering N.W. with part of the light sails set. Middle part working to windward Latter part steering N.W. so Ends Lat 011° N

Friday Sept 25<sup>th</sup> 178° 26' W

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.E. steering N.W. with all sail set. Middle part heading N.W. Latter part steering S.W. so Ends Lat 052° N

Lon 179.13 W

On the line 2<sup>nd</sup> Voyage Sept. 1857

Saturday Sept 26<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E steering S.W. with all sail set. Middle and Latter part the same so Ends Lat 057° S

Sunday Sept 27<sup>th</sup> Lon 179.38 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.E. heading S.W. with all sail set. Middle part heading N.E. Latter part heading S. so Ends Lat 1° 58' S

Monday Sept 28<sup>th</sup> Lon 179.29 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E.N.E. heading S. with all sail set. Middle part heading S.E. Latter part at six saw sperm whals at seven lowered the boats at twelve the boats in chase so Ends

Tuesday Sept 29<sup>th</sup> No Ob

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light air from E. working to windward the boats in chase of whals at two the boats came to the ship. at four lowered the boats again at seven came to the ship. the whals going quick to N.E. Middle and Latter part Calm so Ends 153° S

Wednesday Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 179.18 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and Calm Middle and Latter part light wind from E heading N.E. with all sail set so Ends Lat 045° S

Lon 179.34 E
