Monday March 27.

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light air from E & E heading S.E. with all sail set Middle and Latter part the same so ends Lat 255° S

Tuesday March 30 Lon 173.12 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light air from S.E. heading E & E with all sail set at five spoke the ship Esmer Morgan of New Bedford forty ments. Out with several hundred barrels of sperm oil Middle and Latter part heading E & E ends this day Noll's.

Wednesday March 31.

This day comes in with equally weather and rain heading E at three spoke the Esmer Morgan Middle and Latter part wind N.W. heading E so ends Lat 3.23 S

Thursday April 1. Lon 173.18 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.E. heading E & E with all sail set Middle and Latter part heading S.E. so ends Lat 5.11 S

Friday April 2. Lon 174.23 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E & E heading S.E. with all sail set Middle and Latter part heading N.E. so ends Lat 5.08 S

Saturday April 3. Lon 174.29 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E heading N.E. with all sail set Middle and Latter part heading N.E. so ends Lat 3.33 S

Lon 174.51 E

On the line 2^d voyage April 1858.

Sunday April 4

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from E & E heading N with the light sails furled Middle and Latter part heading E & E under reef so ends Lat 353 S

Monday April 5 Lon 175.33 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from E & E heading S.E. under reef Middle part backed at twelve to N. Latter part heading N by 6 so ends Lat 4.03 S

Tuesday April 6 Lon 175.47 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and strong wind from E & E heading N with the light sails furled Middle and Latter part the same so ends Lat 21 S

Wednesday April 7 Lon 175.46 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E & E heading N with part of the light sails set Middle part heading S.E. Latter part heading N. so ends this day Lat 3.35 S

Thursday April 8. Lon 175.53 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from E & E heading S.E. with all sail set Middle and Latter part equally heading E & E so ends Lat 4.22 S

Friday April 9. Lon 176.30 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather and light wind from N.E. heading E & E with all sail set Middle part the same Latter part at eight saw sperm whales and lowered the boats the Starboard boat struck and captured at half past eleven took the whale along side so ends Noll's.
