N.W. with all sail set. Middle part
heading N.N.E under reefs Latter part
steering S by W with all sail Lat 025 S

Sunday Nov 28. Lon 166.22 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from E steering N.W.
with all sail set. Middle part
heading N.N.E under reefs Latter part
steering S by W with all sail Lat 00
Ends. Lat 00.00

Monday Nov 29. Lon 167.42 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from E steering N.W.
with all sail set. Middle part heading
N.N.E under reefs Latter part steering
S at 6 even saw Pleasant Island
in the middle part Lacked at Twelve
to S.S.E to Ends Lat 010 S

Tuesday Nov 30. Lon 166.55 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from E heading S.S.E
with all sail set at Three the natives
came on board. with hogs fowls and
coconuts, from Three to five with the
main top sail aback, Trading with
the natives Middle and Latter part
calm and a light air working to E
with all sail set to Ends Lat 023 S

Lon 166.56 E

On the line 2^d Voyage Dec 1858.

Wednesday Dec 1.

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light air from E heading N.N.E
with all sail set. Middle part working
to E Latter part heading E.N.E at nine
spoke the Bark rattle of Devon London
to Ends. Do Obs.

Thursday Dec 2.

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from E working to E with
all sail set. at six Pleasant Island
bearing E by S Twelve milds distance
Middle part working to windward
Latter part. at nine the natives came
on board from Pleasant Island.
Trading for hogs fowls & coconuts.
to Ends Do Obs.

Friday Dec 3.

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from S.E Trading with
the natives at five the natives left
at six the Island bearing E.S.E five
milds distance steering N.W. with all sail
set. Middle part steering N Latter part
wind E heading N.N.E at half past eleven
saw Sperm whales to Ends Lat 032 N

Saturday Dec 4. Lon 166.00 E

This day comes in with pleasant weather
and light wind from E. at half past twelve
lowered the boats the Larboard & Mast boat
struck and captured at seven the whales
along side and shortened sail Middle
part under short sail Latter part at
day light commenced cutting
